Eardley Knollys

Edward (Eardley) Knollys (born 1902, Alresford, Hampshire) was a British artist, art critic, and art dealer. In 1936, Knollys began working with Austrian art dealer Ala Story at her gallery, Storran Gallery in London. Story later sold her share of the business to Knollys, where he exhibited artists such as Monet, Renoir, Gauguin, Picasso, Vlaminck, Derain, Picasso and Modigliani. Following the end of World War II, and the death of Knollys' partner Frank Coombs, the gallery eventually closed.

Knollys, along with Eddy Sackville-West, and Desmond Shawe-Taylor, went on to purchase the Long Crichel House in Dorset to create an intellectual salon, hosting guests including Sybil Colefax, Anthony Asquith, Graham Sutherland, Lord Berners, Nancy Mitford, Benjamin Britten, Laurie Lee, Ben Nicolson, Cecil Day-Lewis, and Graham Greene.

Knollys was also an artist, who worked primarily in watercolor, and often featured rural Hampshire landscapes.
