#### **Peter Britt**

Peter Britt (1819-1905) of Obstalden, Switzerland, was a portrait painter and photographer, meteorologist, and horticulturalist. Britt was an early settler in the Rogue Valley of Oregon Territory, building a log cabin in Jacksonville in 1852. He opened P. Britt's Photograph and Daguerreotype Room, a photography studio, in Jacksonville in 1856. Following his purchase of a stereo camera in the 1860s, Britt became an outdoor and gallery photographer, taking pictures of the Oregon Coast, the North Coast of California, the Siskiyou Mountains, the Rogue River, the Klamath River, the Cascades, and Crater Lake.

Britt married Amalia Grob (1822-1871) in 1861. The couple had three children: Emil Britt (1862-1950), Arnold Britt (1864-1864), and Amalia Britt (1865-1954). Emil Britt became a photographer, working with his father beginning in 1883.
