Processing Information

Roxana Robinson (1946-)

Roxana Robinson is the author of over ten works of fiction and nonfiction, including the biography *Georgia O'Keeffe: A Life* (1989), widely considered one of the most comprehensive biographies on the artist. *The Washington Post* selected Robinson's novel *Cost* as one of the five best novels of 2008. *Cost* also received critical acclaim from the *Chicago Tribune*, *Library Journal*, *The Seattle Times*, and *The Wall Street Journal*, and was longlisted for the Dublin IMPAC Prize for Fiction. Additionally, her novel *Sparta* (2014) won the Maine Fiction award and was named one of the ten best books of the year by the BBC. Robinson has been awarded fellowships from the Guggenheim Foundation, the National Education Association, and the MacDowell Colony. She served as president of the Authors Guild from 2013 to 2017. Most recently, Robinson received the Barnes & Noble Writers for Writers Award in 2019.

Robinson was born on November 30, 1946 in Pine Mountain, Kentucky, and raised in New Hope, Pennsylvania. She is descended from several notable American families including the Beecher family (Henry Ward Beecher, Lyman Beecher, Harriet Beecher Stowe), the Trumbull family (Jonathan Trumbull), the Scoville family, and the Gallaudet family (Thomas Hopkins Gallaudet, pioneer of American education for the deaf).

Robinson received her B.A. in English Literature at the University of Michigan. Prior to writing fiction, she worked in the art department at Sotheby's and wrote about late nineteenth and early twentieth-century American art. She has taught at institutions including Wesleyan University, University of Houston, and The New School in New York City. She currently teaches in the MFA program at Hunter College.

Scope and Contents

The Roxana Robinson Papers consists of writings, correspondence, photographs, personal papers, teaching files, printed materials, computer media, and audiovisual media documenting the life and work of author Roxana Robinson, dated from circa 1960 to 2018. Writings include research files, notes, clippings, drafts, typescripts, correspondence, and interview transcripts related to the publication of Robinson's biography *Georgia O'Keeffe: A Life* and her play *Georgia O'Keeffe*, as well as six novels, and short stories featured in publications such as *House and Garden*, *The New Yorker*, *The New York Times*, and *Vogue*. Materials related to Robinson's research on O'Keeffe include copies of O'Keeffe's correspondence with Alfred Stieglitz and Anita Pollitzer, and Robinson's interview with Juan Hamilton. Correspondence contains over twenty years of correspondence between Robinson and Guislaine Morland, author of *The Food of Love*, as well as correspondence and subject files pertaining to Robinson's novels, short stories, and public appearances. Photographs consist of publicity stills of Robinson. Teaching files contain syllabi, course outlines, articles, and notes related to teaching positions Robinson held at institutions including the University of Houston, Wesleyan University, and The New School. Printed materials feature Robinson's novels, short stories, articles, essays, and reviews of her work by others. Computer and audiovisual media include interviews, drafts, and audio recordings on computer discs, floppy disks, optical media, videocassettes, and audiocassettes.

The collection is organized into seven series: I. Writings, circa 1960-2018 and undated. II. Correspondence, 1978-2010 and undated. III. Photographs, circa 1985-2009 and undated. IV. Teaching Files, 1991-2008. V. Personal Papers, 1965-2009. VI. Printed Materials, 1974-2011. VII. Computer and Audiovisual Media, 1982-2005 and undated.

Collection Contents

Series I: Writings, circa 1960–2018 and undated

This series contains research files, notes, drafts, typescripts, page proofs, galley proofs, and correspondence related to Robinson's writings. A large portion of the series consists of research for Robinson's biography *Georgia O'Keeffe: A Life*, including materials gathered from the Alfred Stieglitz/Georgia O'Keeffe Archive at the Beinecke Library. There are also drafts, correspondence, and publicity for Robinson's play about O'Keeffe, and files for her short stories, articles, essays, reviews, and six novels.

Organized into three subseries: *Georgia O'Keeffe: A Life*, Novels, and Shorter Works.

Georgia O'Keeffe: A Life

This subseries contains Robinson's files for her biography *Georgia O'Keeffe: A Life*, including transcribed letters, photocopies of correspondence, typescripts, and interview transcripts, as well as Robinson's notes, notebooks, and drafts. Photocopies of materials from the Alfred Stieglitz/Georgia O'Keeffe Archive date from circa 1967, when Robinson conducted her research, while original materials Robinson consulted within the archive date from 1873.

Materials maintain order found at time of acquisition.
