## MARIANNE MOORE, 1887-1972

Marianne Moore, poet and editor of *The Dial* (1925-1929), was a long-time friend of Monroe Wheeler and Glenway Wescott, whom she met in the early 1920s while living in New York City.

## Scope and Contents

The Glenway Wescott and Monroe Wheeler Collection of Marianne Moore contains miscellaneous manuscript items, notes, and ephemera related to Moore which were found among the Wescott and Wheeler papers. The material covers the dates 1923-72.

The collection is housed in 2 boxes and is organized into three series: I. *Writings*; II. *Wheeler and Wescott Notes on Marianne Moore*; and III. *Other Material*.

<u>Series I, Writings</u>, contains printed copies of works by Moore from newspapers and magazines, as well as two cards which reproduce Moore manuscripts, and production materials for a Museum of Modern Art book, *Eight Poems*, which include holograph texts in Moore's hand prepared for reproduction.

<u>Series II, Wheeler and Wescott Notes on Marianne Moore</u>, contains notes and journals entries made by the two men.

<u>Series III, Other Materials</u>, includes loose clippings, drafts of writings by Monroe Wheeler on Moore, material concerning readings, Moore memoribilia, and exhibition materials.
