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## Processing Information

Collections are processed to a variety of levels, depending on the work necessary to make them usable, their perceived research value, the availability of staff, competing priorities, and whether or not further accruals are expected. The library attempts to provide a basic level of preservation and access for all collections as they are acquired, and does more extensive processing of higher priority collections as time and resources permit.

This collection received a basic level of processing, including rehousing and minimal organization. Various acquisitions associated with the collection have been partially interfiled and organized into series, and later acquisitions have been described separately in the contents list below.

Information included in the Description of Papers note and Collection Contents section is drawn from information supplied with the collection and from an initial survey of the contents. Folder titles appearing in the contents list below are often based on those provided by the creator or previous custodian. Titles have not been verified against the contents of the folders in all cases. Otherwise, folder titles are supplied by staff during initial processing.

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## Keith Botsford (1928-)

Keith Botsford (1928-2018) was born in Brussels, Belgium. He was an European-American author and Professor Emeritus of Journalism at Boston University. He authored numerous novels, articles, essays and translations, and was the editor of *News from the Republic of Letters*.

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## Scope and Contents

The papers contain correspondence, writings, and other papers that document the life and work of Keith Botsford. Correspondence is both professional and personal, and documents Botsford's writing and editing activity, as well as his involvement in International PEN and the Congress for Cultural Freedom. Writings

include corrected typescript and autograph manuscript drafts, proofs and other related material. Other papers include a small quantity of personal documents and photographs.

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## Collection Contents

### Series I: Correspondence, 1941-1969

Series I consists of the personal and professional correspondence of Keith Botsford spanning the years 1941 to 1969. While correspondence is chiefly incoming, some files include retained copies of outgoing letters. The correspondence documents Botsford's writing and editing projects (including the early years of his collaboration with Saul Bellow), his activities with International PEN, the Congress for Cultural Freedom, and other organizations, and events that Botsford attended.

Principal correspondents include Saul Bellow, Rolf Fjelde, Helga Greene, Iain Hamilton, John Houseman, Jack Ludwig, Henri Peyre, Lawrence Richardson, Harvey Shapiro, and Roger Shattuck.

Organized into two subseries: General Correspondence, and Third Party Correspondence and Other Papers.
