Processing Information

This collection received a preliminary level of processing, including rehousing, minimal organization, and listing of contents, upon receipt by the Library. In 2007-2008, the contents list was migrated to comply with current archival descriptive standards. Further rehousing and description was carried out in 2012.

Folder titles appearing in the contents list below are often based on those provided by the creator or previous custodian. Henry Adams La Farge (1902-1985)

Henry Adams La Farge (1902-1985), grandson of the American artist John La Farge, was an art administrator, historian, and editor. He edited the book *Lost Treasures of Europe: 427 Photographs* (1946) and compiled a catalogue raisonné of works by John La Farge that was never published.

John La Farge (1835-1910)

John La Farge (1835-1910), American painter, muralist, stained-glass designer, and writer.

Scope and Contents
