Processing Information

This collection received a basic level of processing, including rehousing and in some instances minimal organization. Various acquisitions associated with the collection have not been merged and organized as a whole. Each acquisition is described separately in the contents list below according to month and year of acquisition.

The finding aid for this collection is compiled from individual preliminary lists for each acquisition that were created at or around the time of receipt by the library. The preliminary lists were migrated to comply with current archival descriptive standards and merged into a single file in 2007-2008.

As a rule, descriptive information found in the Collection Contents section is drawn in large part from information supplied with the collection and from an initial survey of the contents. Folder titles appearing in the contents list below are often based on those provided by the creator or previous custodian. Titles have not been verified against the contents of the folders in all cases. Otherwise, folder titles are supplied by staff during processing.

This finding aid may be updated periodically to account for new acquisitions to the collection and/or revisions in arrangement and description.

Maxine Kumin (1925-)

Maxine Kumin was born Maxine Winokur on 6 June 1925 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and educated at Radcliffe College (1946, 1948). Kumin worked as an instructor and lecturer in English and Tufts University for several years between 1958 and 1968 and has held visiting appointments at other institutions around

the country since the 1970s. She is the author of numerous children's books, poetry collections, essay and short story collections, and novels, and her many awards include the Pulitzer Prize (1973) for *Up Country*, American Academy and Institute of Arts and Letters Award for excellence in literature (1980), Poets' Prize (1994) and Aiken Talyor Poetry Prize (1995) for *Looking For Luck*, and Ruth Lilly Poetry Prize (1999). Since 1976, she and her husband have lived on a farm in Warner, New Hampshire.

Scope and Contents

The collection contains writings, correspondence, and other materials documenting Maxine Kumin's literary work and professional and public activities since 1960. Writings include drafts, proofs, and other materials relating to book-length and shorter works. Kumin wrote children's books, poetry collections, essay and short story collections, and novels, and files can be found for works dating from the early children's book *A Winter Friend* (1961) to the late collection of poems, *Still to Mow* (2007). Large files can be found for a variety of work: *The Abduction* (1971), *The Long Approach* (1985), *Looking For Luck* (1992), *Women, Animals, and Vegetables* (1994), *Selected Poems 1960-1990* (1997), *Quit Monks or Die* (1999), *Inside the Halo and Beyond the Journey* (1999), *Always Beginning* (2000), and *Jack and Other New Poems* (2005).

Correspondence in the collection can be found with writers, literary critics, publishers, and family. Correspondents include: Dudley Fitts, William Meredith, Howard Nemerov, Anne Sexton, and the publishers Harper & Row, McGraw-Hill, W. W. Norton, Viking, and North Point Press. The March 2013 Acquisition contains a large file of correspondence, dating from 1945 and 1946, between Maxine Kumin and her husband Victor.

Other materials appear chiefly to document Kumin's professional and public activities. There are financial and legal records, such as contracts and permissions, correspondence and documents relating to speaking engagements and participation on literary juries and in the Bread Loaf Writers' Conference; printed materials, including reviews and publicity; audiovisual materials, including both sound and video recordings of readings by Kumin, interviews, and other cultural events; and personal papers, such as calendars and photographs.

The March 1990 Acquisition includes writings, correspondence, and other professional and personal papers. Writings include drafts, proofs, and other materials relating to book-length and shorter works. Kumin wrote children's books, poetry collections, essay and short story collections, and novels, and files can be found for *A Winter Friend* (1961), *The Abduction* (1971), *The Designated Heir* (1974), and *The Long Approach* (1985), among others. There is also correspondence with writers, literary critics, and publishers, including Dudley Fitts, William Meredith, Howard Nemerov, Anne Sexton, *Atlantic Monthly*, *Poetry Magazine*, *Saturday Review*, Harper and Row, McGraw-Hill, and W. W. Norton. Other materials chiefly document Kumin's professional activities, such as speaking engagements and participation on literary juries and in the Bread Loaf Writers' Conference.
