Collections are processed to a variety of levels, depending on the work necessary to make them usable, their perceived research value, the availability of staff, competing priorities, and whether or not further accruals are expected. The library attempts to provide a basic level of preservation and access for all collections as they are acquired, and does more extensive processing of higher priority collections as time and resources permit.

This collection received a basic level of processing, including rehousing and minimal organization, in 2013. Information included in the Description of Papers note and Collection Contents section is drawn from information supplied with the collection and from an initial survey of the contents. Folder titles appearing in the contents list below are often based on those provided by the creator or previous custodian. Titles have not been verified against the contents of the folders in all cases. Otherwise, folder titles are supplied by staff during initial processing.

This finding aid may be updated periodically to account for new acquisitions to the collection and/or revisions in arrangement and description.

Simon Perchik (1923-)

Simon Perchik was born in Paterson, New Jersey, in 1923. After serving as a pilot in the Army Air Corps during the Second World War, he enrolled in New York University, where he received a B.A. in English and an L.L.B. in law. Perchik wrote poetry and practiced law from 1950 to 1980, after which he retired to write full-time. Among Perchik's published collections of poetry are *I counted only April* (New Rochelle, NY: Elizabeth Press, 1964) and *Hands collected: the books of Simon Perchik: poems, 1949-1999* (Columbus, OH: Pavement Saw Press, 2000).

Scope and Contents
