Processing Information

This collection received a basic level of processing in 2014, including rehousing and in some instances minimal organization. Various acquisitions associated with the collection have not been merged and organized as a whole. Each acquisition is described separately in the contents list below, identified by a unique call number and titled according to month and year of acquisition.

The finding aid for this collection is compiled from individual preliminary lists for each acquisition that were created at or around the time of receipt by the library. The preliminary lists were migrated to comply with current archival descriptive standards and merged into a single file in 2007-2008. As part of the migration, modifications were made to the formatting of individual lists; however, the content of the lists was neither modified nor verified.

As a rule, descriptive information found in the Collection Contents section is drawn in large part from information supplied with the collection and from an initial survey of the contents. Folder titles appearing in the contents list below are often based on those provided by the creator or previous custodian. Titles have not been verified against the contents of the folders in all cases. Otherwise, folder titles are supplied by staff during initial processing.

Edmund White (1940-)

Edmund White (1940-), American novelist, memoirist, and essayist. White was affiliated with a literary group known as the Violet Quill, whose seven members are regarded as one of the strongest collective voices of the gay male experience in the post-Stonewall era.

Scope and Contents

The Edmund White Papers provide insight into the professional and personal life of Edmund White, an American novelist, memoirist, and essayist, and are comprised of correspondence, drafts of writings, research files, personal papers, financial papers, photographs, slides, audiovisual material, computer media, and ephemera.

[Series II, Writings](#), is contained in Boxes 3-19 and arranged alphabetically by title. It includes manuscripts and typescripts for *The Beautiful Room is Empty*, *A Boy's Own Story*, and *Nocturne for the King of Naples*, as well as manuscripts for several unpublished early works, among them "Private Disquisitions" and "An Amorous History of Youth." There are also manuscripts, typescripts and printed copies of many shorter works, articles, and reviews by White, as well as extensive research files for *States of Desire*.

[Series III, Financial Papers](#), fills Boxes 20-22 and contains cancelled checks, checkbooks, tax returns, and various bills and receipts. Box 23 houses [Series IV, Clippings](#), which is divided into two sections: "Interviews" and "Clippings about Edmund White." [Series V, Personal Papers](#), contains two folders of juvenilia, a diary, school papers, awards and memorabilia. [Photographs, Series VI](#), contains portraits of Edmund White, his family, and friends, and includes a Robert Mapplethorpe photograph of White with Truman Capote.
