SUMMARY: The Flora Stieglitz Straus Collection of Stieglitz Family Papers consists of letters, photographs, printed materials, journals, and a scrapbook documenting the lives of Alfred Stieglitz's extended family. Included in the first series, Stieglitz Family Papers, are letters between family members, a draft of an autobiography by Edward J. Stieglitz, and biographical information about Julius Stieglitz. Series II, Alfred Stieglitz and Georgia O'Keeffe, contains a number of letters from Stieglitz and Georgia O'Keeffe to Elizabeth Stieglitz Davidson and Donald Douglas Davidson, and to Flora Stieglitz Straus. Series III, Leopold Stieglitz, consists of material concerning his life, including several journals from the 1880s. Series IV, Addition (1999) contains a group of lantern slides that copy earlier family photographs. Series V, Addition (2000) adds several letters, photographs and family items. Series VI, Addition (2005) contains five autochromes made by Nathan Straus Jr., with their diascope viewers; portraits include Flora Stieglitz Straus, her husband Hugh Grant Straus, and her maternal grandmother Jacobina Staerk Stieffel. Series VII, Addition (2008) includes correspondence, financial papers, photographs, diaries, and albums that document the friends, travels, and activities of the Stieglitz family in Europe and New York City, as well as at their summer home, Oaklawn, just north of the village of Lake George, New York.

Immediate Source of Acquisition

The majority of the items in this collection were the bequest of the estate of Flora Stieglitz Straus. Other items were given by Stieglitz family members Sue Davidson Lowe and Elizabeth Davidson Murray. Much of the material concerning Leopold Stieglitz was collected by Robert Simpson and given to Flora Stieglitz Straus by Mrs. Simpson in 1972. Material in Series V was given by Sue Davidson Lowe in 1999 and added to the collection in 2000. The autochromes in Series VI were given by Ann Straus Gertler. Material in Series VII is from the estate of Flora Stieglitz Straus.

Information about the Stieglitz family is readily available in many books about Alfred Stieglitz, including Sue Davidson Lowe's *Stieglitz: A Memoir/Biography*, which includes a detailed family tree that is very helpful in sorting out the photographer's extended family. The Flora Stieglitz Straus Collection contains a

photocopy of a typescript draft of an autobiography by Edward J. Stieglitz ("Search for Maturity") that also includes biographical information about Julius Stieglitz. In addition, readers are directed to Herbert Newby McCoy's *Julius Stieglitz, 1867-1937: A Biographical Sketch*.

Scope and Contents

The Flora Stieglitz Straus Collection of Stieglitz Family Papers consist of letters, photographs, printed materials, journals, manuscripts, albums, and a scrapbook documenting the lives of many members of Alfred Stieglitz's extended family, in particular his father Edward and brothers Julius and Leopold, with some early correspondence to and from Stieglitz. The collection spans the years 1860-1999 and was accumulated mainly by Flora Stieglitz Straus (1895-1994), the niece of Alfred Stieglitz. Material in this collection complements other family papers found in Series XI of the Alfred Stieglitz/Georgia O'Keeffe Archive (YCAL MSS 85).

Included in the first series, Stieglitz Family Papers, are letters between family members, a draft of an autobiography by Edward J. Stieglitz, and biographical information about Julius Stieglitz. Series II, Alfred Stieglitz and Georgia O'Keeffe, contains a number of letters from Stieglitz and O'Keeffe to Elizabeth Stieglitz Davidson and Donald Douglas Davidson, and to Flora Stieglitz Straus. Series III, Leopold Stieglitz, consists of material concerning him and includes several of his journals from the 1880s. Series IV, Addition (1999), is a collection of lantern slides. Series V, Addition (2000), contains several letters, photographs and family items. Series VI, Addition (2005), consists of five autochrome portraits and their viewing devices. Series VII, Addition (2008), includes correspondence, financial papers, photographs, and albums that document the travels and activities of the Stieglitz family in Europe, New York City, and at their summer home, Oaklawn, just north of the village of Lake George, New York.

Because the material in this collection came from a number of family sources, the same types of documents (correspondence, invoices, photographs, etc.) will appear in many of the series.

Arrangement

The collection is organized into seven series: I. Stieglitz Family (1867-1990); II. Alfred Stieglitz and Georgia O'Keeffe (1880-1992); III. Leopold Stieglitz (1878-1954); IV. Addition (1999): Lantern Slides (circa 1920); V. Addition (2000): Correspondence, Photographs, Other Papers (1863-1999); VI. Addition (2005): Autochromes (circa 1915); VII. Addition (2008): Manuscripts, Photographs, Ephemera (1860-1945). Boxes 8, 9, and 18 contain Oversize items. Box 10 contains Restricted Fragile Papers for which preservation copies have been made.

Collection Contents

Series I: Stieglitz Family, 1867-1990

0.83 linear feet (2 boxes)

The series holds a variety of letters, photographs, and family papers. *Correspondence* contains letters between family members, which include several picture postcards collected by Sue Davidson Lowe. *Photographs* contains many portraits of family members, including the twin brothers Leopold and Julius Stieglitz, and images of Stieglitz family homes in Lake George and Mamaroneck, New York. [Copy negatives for several prints accompanied this collection. They are stored separately.] Among the *Other Papers* is the draft of an autobiography by gerontologist Edward J. Stieglitz ("Search for Maturity," which also contains biographical information about his father Julius Stieglitz), and a scrapbook kept by Elizabeth Stieffel Stieglitz.

Series II: Alfred Stieglitz and Georgia O'Keeffe, 1880-1992*0.63 linear feet (2 boxes)*

The series brings together materials documenting the life of the photographer and his second wife that were collected by several family members. Along with the clippings and exhibition catalogs are a number of runs of correspondence. These include letters from Alfred Stieglitz to Elizabeth Stieglitz Davidson and Donald Douglas Davidson, and to Elizabeth Stieffel Stieglitz, Leopold Stieglitz, and Flora Stieglitz Straus, as well as letters from Georgia O'Keeffe to Donald Douglas Davidson, to Elizabeth Stieglitz Davidson, and to Flora Stieglitz Straus. This series also contains a typescript carbon of an essay ("Joke") by Benjamin de Casseres written for "291" and a bookplate for Alfred Stieglitz most likely designed by Allen Lewis.

Series III: Leopold Stieglitz, 1878-1954*1.04 linear feet (3 boxes)*

The series contains papers related to Alfred Stieglitz's younger brother Leopold, who gained renown as a physician. The first subseries contains routine personal and professional *Correspondence*. The second subseries, *Writings*, consists of items on medical topics along with stories and plays. Among the *Personal Papers* are several volumes of journals that cover Stieglitz's school days in Germany during the 1880s, and his diplomas and awards.

Series IV: Addition (1999): Lantern Slides, circa 1920*0.25 linear feet (1 box)*

The series contains a group of lantern slides that copy earlier family photographs. Descriptions of the images were taken from a list provided by Sue Davidson Lowe; according to a note accompanying the material, Flora Straus recalled in 1986 that the slides were probably made for her by Alfred Stieglitz, and were shown at a family New Years Eve celebration in the early 1920s.

Three photographs are of Flora Stieglitz Straus, with one each of her husband Hugh Grant Straus (1890-1961), and her maternal grandmother Jacobina Staerk Stieffel; they were made around 1915 by Nathan Straus Jr. (1889-1961), the brother of Hugh Straus. The diascope viewers are leather-covered transparency viewing devices patented in 1908 by the New York manufacturer L. A. Dubernet; each holder has a mirror on the back of a folding bellows which allows light to reflect back through the autochrome.

The first subseries, *Manuscripts*, includes a series of letters written by Alfred Stieglitz while a he was student in Germany, other letters written to Edward Stieglitz by family and friends, a set of hotel receipts documenting the Stieglitz family's travels in Germany and Switzerland in 1866, and invoices for household expenditures in Lake George and furnishings for their home in New York. It also holds friendship volumes kept by two of the Stieglitz sisters, Agnes and Selma, which were inscribed and drawn in by their friends and family members in Europe and America, including the artists Fedor Encke, Moses Jacob Ezekiel, Wilhelm Hasemann, and Otto Rauth. Also present are two partial diaries kept by Edward Stieglitz and his granddaughter Katherine ("Kitty") Stieglitz Stearns.

Photographs is arranged under the headings of Albums, Individuals, Groups, and Miscellaneous. There are three photograph albums which hold snapshot-quality images of the Stieglitz family at home and at play in Europe and New York City (Manhattan and Queens), and at Lake George. Many of the images in box 17 are duplicated in other series in this collection, as well as in the Stieglitz/O'Keeffe Archive (YCAL MSS 85). *Ephemera* holds theatre handbills from performances in Germany in 1866.
