Biographical / Historical

Arthur Clarence Walworth, historian and author, was born in Newton, Massachusetts, in 1903. He received a B.A. degree from Yale in 1925. Walworth taught English and modern European history in China and traveled in Japan and Europe. In 1927 he joined the educational department of Houghton Mifflin. Walworth received the Pulitzer Prize in biography in 1958 for his book on Woodrow Wilson. He is the author of School Histories at War, 1938; Black Ships off Japan, 1946; Cape Breton, 1948; The Medomak Way, 1953; Woodrow Wilson, 2 vols., 1958; America's Moment, 1918, 1977; and Wilson and His Peacemakers, 1986. Walworth died on January 10, 2005, in Needham, Massachusetts.

The papers consist of correspondence, research materials, and writings on Woodrow Wilson, Commodore Perry's expedition, and American diplomacy at the end of World War I. Correspondence with biographer Phyllis Levin is included in the papers.

This accession consists of a recording made on June 7, 1989, during which Arthur Walworth reads an account of his 1925 visit to the Republic of China to an unidentified audience at North Hill. Walworth recalls arriving in Ch'ang-sha, the capital of Hunan sheng (province), where he taught English at the Yale-in-China medical school. The account continues with descriptions of student protests and other revolutionary activities that rocked China as Nationalist and Communist forces clashed. The tape also includes Walworth's interactions with Christian missionaries in China; descriptions of Chinese leaders, such as Chiang Kai-shek and Mao Tse-tung; and Walworth's personal experiences and reflections on his trip.
