**SUMMARY:** The papers include correspondence, writings, speeches, memoranda, and photographs, documenting Dean Acheson's life after leaving the U.S. State Department in 1953. Also documented is his work as a member of the Yale Corporation and his long friendship with Felix Frankfurter, Archibald MacLeish, and others. The correspondence and memoranda contain Acheson's views on many contemporary issues in American foreign policy such as Korea, the Middle East, NATO, Germany, the war in Vietnam, and Rhodesia and South Africa. The papers also include Acheson's later reflections on his years in public life and assessments of the U.S. government under the Kennedy, Johnson, and Nixon administrations. Acheson's numerous correspondents include personal friends, American and foreign government officials, journalists, and a wide range of other persons in public life. The papers also include manuscripts, notes, and reviews for several of Acheson's books.

## Biographical / Historical

Dean Gooderham Acheson was born in Middletown, Connecticut, on April 11, 1893, to Edward Campion and Eleanor Gertrude Gooderham Acheson. His father was the Episcopal bishop of Connecticut. Acheson graduated from the Groton School in 1911 and entered Yale University, where he was in the same class

(Y1915) with Archibald MacLeish. Acheson would hold his college ties dear, and in later years he would serve as a member of the Yale Corporation and a confidant of President A. Whitney Griswold.

From New Haven, Acheson moved to the challenging intellectual climate of the Harvard Law School. Here he came under the influence of Felix Frankfurter. He received his law degree in 1918 and then worked for two years as a law clerk to Supreme Court Justice Louis D. Brandeis. In 1921, Acheson joined the law firm of Covington & Burling in Washington, D.C. Acheson would continue to be affiliated with the law firm, or its successors Covington, Burling and Rublee, and Covington, Burling, Acheson and Shorb for the remainder of his life.

In May 1933, President Franklin D. Roosevelt named Acheson to the post of under secretary of the Treasury. Acheson resigned five months later following a disagreement over Roosevelt's gold-purchasing program and resumed his Washington law practice.

Acheson returned to government service in 1941 as assistant secretary of state for economic policy. In this position he helped manage the Lend-Lease program and he was instrumental in the development of several postwar institutions such as the International Monetary Fund and the Bretton Woods agreement, which led to the creation of the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (World Bank).

From 1945 to 1947, Acheson held the post of under secretary, often functioning as the acting secretary of state for the absent James Byrnes. Acheson became a trusted advisor to President Truman and in 1949, following a short term away from the State Department, President Truman asked Acheson to be his secretary of state, replacing George C. Marshall. In this post war period, Acheson became the principal architect of United States' Cold War foreign policy. He helped to forge an alliance between America and Western Europe to oppose the Soviet Union and the expansion of Communism.

Acheson feared that the Soviet Union would be able to expand its sphere of influence over the Middle East, and in 1947 he orchestrated military and economic aid to the governments of Greece and Turkey under what came to be known as the Truman Doctrine. In that same year, he outlined the main points of the Marshall Plan for war-ravaged Europe. Forecasting that political and social upheaval might result if conditions did not improve quickly, Acheson advocated a massive American economic aid package to stabilize and rehabilitate seventeen western and southern European nations.

Acheson also believed that collective defense would be necessary to stop further Soviet advances, and one of his first accomplishments as secretary of state was to facilitate the formation of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO). When Communist North Korea invaded South Korea in June 1950, Acheson immediately labeled this an act of aggression and moved swiftly to secure a United Nations Security Council emergency session resolution condemning the North Korean attack. For the first time an international organization sanctioned a military response to halt an infringement on another country's sovereignty, and American troops, under UN authority and General Douglas MacArthur's direction, entered combat in Korea. War on the Korean peninsula would command the attention of Truman and his advisors for the duration of the administration.

Acheson was a controversial government official and a lightning rod for criticism. During his time in the State Department, the governments in countries in Eastern Europe and China became Communist. Acheson was accused of being "soft on communism." Republican Senator Joseph R. McCarthy declared that the State Department was harboring communists, and Acheson's refusal to testify against Alger Hiss brought calls for his resignation.

After leaving public office, Acheson continued to voice his opinions on foreign policy through his lectures and writing. He gamely played the role of elder statesman and would serve as an unofficial advisor to the Kennedy, Johnson, and Nixon administrations. His book, *Present at the Creation*, won a Pulitzer Prize.

In 1917, Acheson had married Alice Stanley. They had three children: Jane Stanley (later wife of Dudley B. W. Brown), David Campion (later husband of Patricia Castles), and Mary Campion (later wife of William P. Bundy). Acheson died suddenly from a stroke at the age of seventy-eight on October 12, 1971.

## Scope and Contents

The Dean Acheson Papers are a rich source of information on the policies, thoughts, and accomplishments of the secretary of state who guided American foreign policy from 1948 to 1953. The papers, which span the period from 1898 to 1989, are especially full for the period after Acheson left public office in 1953 until his death in 1971. Included in the correspondence, speech and lecture files, manuscripts of books and articles, and memoranda, which compose the papers, are examinations of such major topics of U.S. foreign policy as Korea; NATO; post-war relations with the Soviet Union, Eastern Europe, and Germany; tensions in the Middle East; the war in Vietnam; and the U.S. posture towards Rhodesia and South Africa. Evaluations of the Truman, Kennedy, Johnson, and Nixon administrations figure prominently in the papers, and Acheson's role as a member of the Yale Corporation is thoroughly documented. Major correspondents include personal friends and professional colleagues.

Acheson considered these papers to be his private papers, as opposed to the papers he created professionally as a lawyer and publicly as a civil servant. Acheson's legal files remain with the firm of Covington & Burling. Many of Acheson's official papers are now in the Harry S. Truman Presidential Library in Independence, Missouri. Acheson's son, David C. Acheson, donated these private papers to Yale University between 1981 and 1983.

This finding aid was edited slightly in 2003 when being converted to an on-line format.

## Collection Contents

### Series I: General Correspondence, 1910-1971

GENERAL CORRESPONDENCE is arranged in general letter files, which contain most of the correspondence with the general public and minimal amounts of very routine correspondence with persons of some prominence; more substantive correspondence is arranged in selected individual files. The files are arranged in alphabetical order with general letter files coming before selected individual files of that letter. Selected files listed with an asterisk (\*) contain ten or more items.

The series contains the bulk of Acheson's correspondence with family and associates, as well as many letters from the general public, and comprises nearly half of the papers. Most of the correspondence dates after 1933, but for the period when Acheson was secretary of state the series shows a noticeable lack of material.

The papers contain few letters to or from Acheson family members. There are single items, ca. 1910, of Acheson's immediate family in folder 1, and there is some correspondence with David Acheson during his military service in World War II. There are copies of the letters to daughter Mary Acheson Bundy, which were later printed in *Present at the Creation*. There are only passing references to Acheson's boyhood in Middletown, Connecticut, and Acheson's years at Groton, Yale, and Harvard are only briefly noted in reminiscences by classmates.

Many of Acheson's earliest letters are to two men who would become his closest friends: Felix Frankfurter, whom Acheson met at Harvard Law School; and Archibald MacLeish, whom Acheson had met during his undergraduate work at Yale. The letters in the files for both Frankfurter and MacLeish trace the development of their careers along with that of Acheson's.

Other friends with whom Acheson had long term and wide ranging correspondences include Wallace Carroll, Raymond E. Lee, Wilmarth Lewis, Randal MacDonald, Edward G. Miller, Jr., Jacob Podoloff, George Rublee, Boylston A. Tompkins, Melvin Truesdale, Joseph Walker, James Warburg, and Frederick Wiener. Lee, a Yale classmate, writes from the C. C. C. Camp in Vermont, where he was an administrator, and from the American embassy in London, where he served as a military attaché just prior to the outbreak of World War II. George Rublee, one of Acheson's legal associates, was from 1928-1930 a legal advisor with Dwight Morrow in Mexico. His letters analyze the contemporary Mexican political situation. In the late 1930s Rublee went to Europe as the director of the International Governmental Committee on Refugees from Germany and Austria, and his letters at the time discuss attempts to enlist the support of German moderates such as Hjalmar Schacht to help prevent the extermination of Jews.

Though there is correspondence dating from Acheson's years as a government official, most of it is routine and/or incomplete. Acheson's outgoing letters during the period consist primarily of form replies to letters of congratulation, encouragement, and commiseration. Incoming letters from the important figures of the post-war era, such as George Kennan, Dean Rusk, Robert Schuman, and Harry Truman contain very little information regarding policy decisions.

Of particular interest to Acheson after his retirement were the continuing problems over Germany, German rearmament, and reunification. John McCloy is a prime correspondent on this subject as is Eugene Rostow. In 1958 Acheson issued a reply, through the American Council on Germany, Inc., to George Kennan's plea for the neutralization of Germany. The files for Christopher Emmet, executive vice chairman of the American Council on Germany, are a useful source on the Kennan statement and on other topics concerning Germany.

U.S. relations with European and Soviet block countries, U.S. defense policies, and nuclear weapons are topics raised in correspondence with George V. Allen, Noel Annan, Lucius Battle, Stewart Alsop, John Kenneth Galbraith, Hubert Humphrey, J. William Fulbright, Hans Morgenthau, and W. Stewart Symington. Belgian banker Camille Gutt discusses the situation in the Congo, and interesting letters addressed to Barbara Evans in 1962 record Acheson's trip to Cambodia and meetings with Prince Sihanouk.

Acheson had many personal friends in Europe and elsewhere with whom he maintained long, full correspondence. The correspondence with Anthony Eden begins in 1952 and continues for twenty years, covering a wide range of topics. Desmond Donnelly and Sir Patrick Devlin wrote on the European Economic Community and relations with DeGaulle and Germany. For correspondences of similar tone and scope see the files for Sir Howard Beale, Lady Pamela Berry, Sir William Elliot, Sir Frederick Leith-Ross, Lady Violet Bonham Carter, Robert Menzies, Lester Pearson, Robert Campos, Pedro Pereira, Lord Frank Stowe-Hill, Thomas Stone, and Sir John Wheeler-Bennett.

Two other of Acheson's most frequent correspondents were John Cowles and J. H. P. Gould. Their correspondence, like that of MacLeish, contains the same forthright exchange of ideas on current U.S. policies, including discussions of John Foster Dulles' leadership, Nikita Khrushchev, national defense, the use of missiles, the 1968 U.S. election, the Nixon administration, the Middle East, Vietnam, Rhodesia, and Russian technological growth.

Acheson served as an unofficial foreign policy advisor to the Kennedy, Johnson, and Nixon administrations, and the correspondence contains exchanges with each president and with members of their cabinets and staffs. In the 1958 exchanges with Johnson, Acheson discussed Democratic Party strategy and the relative importance of issues such as civil rights, school integration, and voting. For discussions of foreign affairs during the Johnson and Nixon administrations see the correspondence with Robert Schaezel, United States representative to the European Communities.

Acheson's opinion of Richard M. Nixon, the Nixon administration, the invasion of Cambodia, and the Nixon administration China policy are included in exchanges with Lincoln MacVeagh, Frank Stowe-Hill, and Sir Roy Welensky, among others. Further views on the Vietnam War can be found in the correspondence with Barbara Tuchman. With Charles Tyroler II, and Paul Douglas, Acheson exchanged views on the formation of the Citizens' Committee for Peace and Freedom in Vietnam. Acheson's views on Vietnam and the Nixon administration brought him praise from a former virulent critic, William Loeb. There are many letters between the two towards the end of Acheson's life. Acheson had known Henry Kissinger before his rise to prominence in the Nixon administration, and the early Kissinger letters contain more substantive discussions of issues than those after 1969.

During the last three years of his life Acheson was preoccupied with questions concerning U.S. relations with Rhodesia and South Africa. He began corresponding with Sir Roy Welensky, and former president of Rhodesia UDI. Welensky wrote seeking Acheson's help and influence with American politicians to alter British and American policies towards Rhodesia. The two exchanged ideas about Wilson's policy in Rhodesia, race relations, and Rhodesian constitutional talks. With Charles Burton Marshall, Acheson testified before the Digg Committee on Rhodesia and South Africa. In correspondence with Philip Jessup, Acheson also discusses the Rhodesian situation and the outlook at the United Nations. Acheson also has some interesting exchanges with Frank Gregory, a young relative from South Africa who visited the United States as an American Field Service exchange student. For other substantive correspondence on Rhodesia and South Africa see the files for Lord Graham, H. L. T. Tasswell, Kenneth Tousey, Ted Xanathy, Denis Black, and Ernest Lefever.

Throughout his life Acheson affirmed his affection and dedication to Yale University, and for twenty years, including his years as secretary of state, he served on the Yale Corporation and was actively involved in the decisions the corporation made. The correspondence with the university's provosts, treasurers and secretaries document Acheson's early work on the Educational Policy Committee, the Budget Committee, and the Library and Museum Committee. In the 1940s Acheson was involved with Yale Law School affairs. In correspondence with Ashabel Gulliver, Charles E. Clark, Eugene Rostow, Harry Shulman, Willard Hurst, and Abe Feller he discusses the recruiting of faculty, the hiring of a new dean, the rivalry with the Harvard Law School, and the university's policy toward the law school.

A. Whitney Griswold, who was chosen to succeed Charles Seymour as president of Yale in 1950, was to become one of Acheson's warmest friends, and the Griswold letters testify to Acheson's involvement in a great many important policy decisions during the 1950s, from major fund raising campaign to outlawing junior fraternities. ## Series II: Correspondence Concerning Speeches and Writings, 1936-1972

## Series III: Speeches and Writings, 1909-1978

Series III is organized in two sections: Chrono File and Books. Chrono File contains all speeches, (\*) lectures, transcribed interviews, articles, letters to the the editor, printed obituary tributes and the like, arranged in chronological order. *Books* contains background material, drafts, correspondence with publishers, editors, and research assistants, reviews and letters of comment from the general public for each of Acheson's books, as well as material used by David Acheson in publishing *Among Friends*. The material is arranged by book title in order of publication.

\* Note: Some tapes of Acheson's speeches, donated with these papers, have been transferred to Historical Sound Recordings for storage and playback. A list of tapes is included in this register as Appendix 1.

Series III, SPEECHES AND WRITINGS, contains copies of Acheson's speeches and writings. All speeches, lectures, transcribed interviews, articles, letters to the editor, printed obituary tributes, and the like are arranged chronologically in the section Chrono File. The file for any particular speech or writing may contain drafts, reading copies, printed copies, and reviews. Folders are listed by date only, but an index, which seems to have been prepared by Barbara Evans, is included in this series in Box 56.

The second section in the series, Books, contains some background material, drafts, correspondence with publishers and editors such as Cass Canfield, Hamish Hamilton, and Eric Swenson, correspondence with research assistants, reviews, and letters of comment from the general public for each of Acheson's books. The material is arranged by book title in order of publication. The section concludes with material used by David Acheson in publishing *Among Friends*, which contains sections of his father's most interesting letters. The last file also contains some of David Acheson's correspondence with his co-editor David McClellan.

Of interest in the files for *Morning and Noon*, one of Acheson's autobiographical volumes, are papers from Acheson's short term in the Treasury Department, 1933. These papers include background material on monetary policy, the gold standard, and British debts, in the form of memoranda and reports. Copies of cables and letters to and from President Roosevelt, Secretary Woodin, and Henry Morgenthau are included.

The greatest quantity of material in the section is for *Present at the Creation*, Acheson's Pulitzer Prize winning memoir of his years in the State Department. There is an extensive correspondence in these files with research assistants Corinne Lyman and Marina Finkelstein, with William Franklin at the Historical Office of the State Department, and with W.W. Norton & Co., the book's publisher. The latter concerns the initial publication, subsequent foreign editions, and paperback college editions of segments under the titles *The Korean War* and *Struggle for Free Europe*. The files also contain a wide range of reviews from around the world.

**Series IV: Miscellaneous Files, 1898-1972**

Material in this series is organized by record type.

The series contains memoranda, certificates, Acheson's doodles and rhymes, and other personal memorabilia; photographs, including several from Acheson's childhood, and 16 mm films; files of miscellaneous background material arranged by subject; and clippings about Acheson and his family.

The memoranda are of, perhaps, the most interest in the series. They begin with a file dating from the time of Felix Frankfurter's confirmation hearings. In 1952 there is a long memorandum containing Acheson's thoughts and observations at the time of the funeral of King George V of England. There are memoranda of conversations with President Truman, Averell Harriman, Krishna Menon, Joseph C. Harsh, Felix Frankfurter, James Reston, President Kennedy, President Nixon, Henry Kissinger, and William Rogers. The memoranda contain Acheson's thoughts on such subjects as Korean prisoners of war, atomic energy, Indochina following the French withdrawal, Joseph McCarthy, Berlin, the assassination of John F. Kennedy, Vietnam, and South Africa.
