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## Scope and Contents

The collection consists of a series of tracings made by John Linnell of 99 of the 102 drawings he commissioned from William Blake to illustrate Dante's *Divina Commedia*. Blake created his ink and watercolor drawings between 1824 and his death in 1827, and Linnell made his tracings in January and February 1831. The drawings are iron-gall ink on tracing paper, measure 44.6 x 56.2 cm and smaller, and are mounted on sheets of heavy paper measuring 61 x 48 cm. Most of the drawings have canto numbers from Dante's poem.

References given after drawing titles are to *Paintings and Drawings of William Blake*, by Martin Butlin (New Haven: Yale University Press, 1981). Missing from the set are tracings of Blake's images number 12, "First Version of Cerberus" (Butlin 812.12), number 15, "The Goddess of Fortune" (Butlin 812.16), and number 50, "The Punishment of the Thieves" (Butlin 812.102).
