## Fausto Giaccone (born 1943)

Fausto Giaccone is an Italian photographer and photojournalist whose work focuses on social movements and cultural issues in Europe, South America, and the Middle East. Born in Tuscany, Italy, in 1943, Giaccone grew up in Palermo and moved to Rome in the mid-1960s to study at the Valle Giulia School of Architecture at the University of Rome. Giaccone began his photojournalism career photographing the student protests at the University in March 1968, an event that became known as the Battle of Valle Giulia. Since the 1960s, Giaccone has worked as a photojournalist, photographing current events for Italian newspapers and other European publications. His subjects have included the Italian student movement of the late 1960s, the Palestinian Fedayeen in Egypt and Jordan, the aftermath of the Carnation Revolution in Portugal, and a survey of European architecture of the 21st century.

His publications include *Una storia portoghese* (Palermo: Randazzo, 1987); *European Millenium Architecture* with Roberto Collova (Vienna: Regina Maria Anzenberger, 2003); *Volti di Cavallino Treporti* (Florence: EDIFIR, 2012); and *Macondo: The World of Gabriel Garcia Marquez* (Rome: Postcart, 2013).

## Scope and Contents

The collection consists of photographs, papers, and publications that document the work of Italian photojournalist Fausto Giaccone (1943-), from 1966 to 2013. The material includes Giaccone's reportage of social and cultural aspects of Europe, South America, and the Middle East, with an emphasis on political movements in Italy and Portugal from 1966 to 1986. The photographic materials in this collection consist of exhibition prints, work prints, contact sheets, and original slides for fifteen photo journalism assignments; prints for three exhibitions; and slides and work prints for two books, as well as a portfolio of color prints. The papers largely document the production of the book *Una storia portoghese* (Palermo: Randazzo, 1987), and include clippings and exhibition reviews. The papers also include exhibition catalogs, publications, and publicity material produced for various projects. Some of Giaccone's publications are also included with the collection.

Photographic projects documented in the collection include reportage of the 1968 student movement in Rome; Palestinian fedayeen in Jordan and Lebanon in 1968 and 1974; the 1981 protest march in Comiso, Sicily; music festivals in Europe; and village life in Southern Italy during the 1970s. Other subjects depicted include fishermen in Mazara del Vallo, Sicily; Paraguayan Mennonites; and city and village life throughout Yugoslavia, 1987 to 1990. Highlighted in the collection is *Una storia portoghese* (A Portuguese Story), a project resulting from two visits Giaccone made to Portugal, in 1975 and 1986, to document rural life in the wake of the Carnation Revolution. Also highlighted in the collection are photographs of Colombia produced for Giaccone's 2013 book, *Macondo: The world of Gabriel García Márquez* (Rome: Postcard, 2013). Sets of prints are also included from three exhibitions: The Battle of Valle Giulia (American Academy in Rome, Rome, 2008), *Viaggio nelle terre dei pastori* (Nuoro, 1982), and *Sicily 1968-1982* (Salemi, 1982).

Publications included with the collection include *Una storia portoghese*, the Italian and Portuguese editions; *Macondo: The world of Gabriel García Márquez*; and *'68 Altrove*.

**Series I: Photographs, 1966-2010***1.3 linear feet (3 boxes)*

Series I consists of photographic prints, including silver gelatin prints and inkjet prints; contact prints; and slides printed by Giaccone from 1966 to 2013 for various projects, assignments, exhibitions, and publications.

Series I is organized chronologically into 21 groups, according to project. The titles for projects were assigned by Giaccone. Within each group, the photographer separated original prints from later prints. The photographs in each project are arranged chronologically based on the date of image creation.

**Series II: Papers, 1975-2013***0.63 linear feet (2 boxes)*

Series II includes textual and digital material compiled by Giaccone for his photographic projects and exhibitions. The largest groups of material document *Una storia portoghese* and *Macondo: The world of Gabriel García Márquez*. Documentation for these publications includes typewritten drafts with manuscript corrections and production dummies. Also included is a typewritten transcript of audio recordings made on August 31, 1975, during the Carnation Revolution. The text contains political discussions and dialogues between Portuguese farm workers and Captain Rodrigues of Movimento Farças Armadas. Also included are clippings and reviews for *Una storia portoghese* as well as exhibition catalogs and publicity material produced for Giaccone's photographic exhibitions.
