## **Biographical / Historical**

Hagop Frank Bozyan was born in 1899. He studied organ at the Yale School of Music, where he received the B.M. degree in 1920. He joined the faculty that year, and continued to teach at Yale until 1965, the year of his death.

## **Scope and Contents**

This collection consists of 16 organ works, 1 song, and 1 piece for piano by Frank Bozyan and his friends and colleagues. 12 of the works are holograph scores. The remaining 6 works are photocopies of the composers' holographs.
