Biographical / Historical

Roberto Sierra is an American composer. He studied at the University of Puerto Rico, the Conservatory of Puerto Rico, the Institute for Sonology in Utrecht, and the Hamburg Hochschule für Musik. In his music, Sierra combines European modernism with Latin American popular music and folk song.

Scope and Contents

The Papers consist mainly of music and programs. Clippings, correspondence and other documents are also included. The collection should be considered partial, as Sierra is currently an active composer.

The Papers are divided into five series: I. Music; II. Programs; III. Clippings; IV. Correspondence; and V. Contracts, Documents and Awards.

The majority of this series includes contracts for composition commissions. Also included are financial documents, biographical notes about Sierra, and photocopies of his university degrees. Awards include a 2009 Grammy nomination and several other award certificates.
