World Performance Project at Yale, 2006-2012

In 2006, Joseph Roach, Charles C. and Dorathea S. Dilley Professor of Theater and English at Yale University, received a Distinguished Achievement Award from the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation. The award recognizes scholars who have made significant contributions to the humanities and enlarged opportunities for scholarship at their institutions, and intends to provide recipients and their institutions with resources to deepen their scholarship. Through funding provided with the award, Professor Roach established the World Performance Project at Yale (WPP). The three-year project was extended through 2012, with funding from the University and residual funds from the initial grant. Affiliated with the Yale College Theater Studies Program and the Whitney Humanities Center, the Project brought artists from throughout the United States, Europe, Latin America, Africa, and Asia to perform and engage in conversations with members of the Yale and the greater New Haven communities. In 2007, the Yale Repertory Theatre joined the World Performance Project in presenting international work and artists in the first of the "No Boundaries" season series, and continued the series after the WPP ended in 2012.

As described in its first season brochure, "The World Performance Project (WPP) promotes programs in performance studies across departments at Yale. An interdisciplinary that draws from the arts, humanities, and human sciences (theater, drama, dance, visual arts, speech, linguistics, anthropology, sociology), performance studies defines as its objects cultural performances of all kinds, from theatrical presentations to rites of passage, and it expands its frontiers anywhere significant performances are likely to take place, from Yorubaland to Disneyland. ... With performance-as-research in mind, the WPP presents performances, workshops, master classes, lectures, and residencies by artists and scholars working in dance, theater, music, performance art, and cultural performance. The WPP strives to frame each event in pre- and post-performance discussion in an effort to deepen the critical reception of the work. Serving

as a central presenting organization, the WPP initiates performance-related events, as it assists and collaborates with departments and programs through the university seeking to enhance their curriculum through live performance.”

Professor Roach served as principal investigator of the Project; Emily Coates, a lecturer in the Yale College Theater Studies program and a professional dancer, served as artistic director; and Kathryn Krier, who was design advisor for the Theater Studies Program, served as technical director/production manager.
