Trevor Winkfield

Trevor Winkfield (born Leeds, England, 1944) is a British-born artist and writer. Winkfield graduated from Leeds College of Art in 1964 and earned an M.A. in Fine Art from the Royal College of Art in London in 1967. Winkfield has lived in New York since 1969. He has collaborated on book cover designs, poetry journals and other writing and art projects with poets and writers, including John Ashbery, Harry Mathews, Charles North, Ron Padgett, James Schuyler, and John Yau. Winkfield's collaborative work included a poetry journal titled *Juilliard*, that was published from 1968-1972.

Scope and Contents

This collection contains correspondence, subject files, writings, artwork, and publication material by or relating to the artist and writer Trevor Winkfield.
