Processing Information

George Washington Grayson

George Washington Grayson (1843-1920) was a writer, publisher, and businessman who also served as a leader for the Creek Nation peoples. Grayson served as a Confederate captain during the American Civil War, then later appointed as chief of the Creek in 1917 by President Woodrow Wilson. Grayson wrote extensively about his life, his work, and Creek culture.

Scope and Contents

Contains writings including transcriptions created by Harold O. Hoppe, correspondence, electronic files, and other papers related to George Washington Grayson's journals and their transcriptions.
