Biographical / Historical

Joy Wolke (1948-2014) (Yale 1974 MA) of San Bernardino, California, studied architecture at Washington State University and environmental design at Yale University. An environmental artist, educator, and public art advocate, Wolke founded Projects for a New Millennium (Projects2K), a nonprofit organization dedicated to the joining of art and science as a means of ecological stewardship. She also taught at various institutions including Yale, RISD, Montana State, and the Glasgow School of Art in Scotland, and was a member of the School of Architecture and Design at Washington State University's advisory council.
