Processing Information

Collections are processed to a variety of levels, depending on the work necessary to make them usable, their perceived research value, the availability of staff, competing priorities, and whether or not further accruals are expected. The library attempts to provide a basic level of preservation and access for all collections as they are acquired, and does more extensive processing of higher priority collections as time and resources permit.

This collection received a basic level of processing, including rehousing and minimal organization. Various acquisitions associated with the collection have not been merged and organized as a whole. Each acquisition is described separately in the contents list below and titled according to month and year of acquisition.

Information included in the Description of Papers note and Collection Contents section is drawn from information supplied with the collection and from an initial survey of the contents. Folder titles appearing in the contents list below are often based on those provided by the creator or previous custodian. Titles have not been verified against the contents of the folders in all cases. Otherwise, folder titles are supplied by staff during initial processing.

This finding aid may be updated periodically to account for new acquisitions to the collection and/or revisions in arrangement and description.

David Underdown

David Underdown (1925-2009) was a historian, author, and educator. Educated at Blue School, Exeter College, Oxford, and Yale University, Underdown wrote and taught extensively about 17th-century English politics and culture. Underdown taught at Yale University from 1986 until his retirement as Professor Emeritus in 1996. He also taught at a number of institutions including Sewanee College, Brown University, and University of Virginia. Among his many award-winning publications, his most well-known work was *Pride's Purge: Politics in the Puritan Revolution* (1981).

Scope and Contents

The David Underdown papers, which span from 1930-2010, contain correspondence, lectures, teaching materials, personal papers, electronic files, and other materials created by or relating to David Underdown's life and work.

Arrangement

Organized into two groupings: January 2013 acquisition; and June 2015 acquisition.
