Processing Information

Collections are processed to a variety of levels, depending on the work necessary to make them usable, their perceived research value, the availability of staff, competing priorities, and whether or not further accruals are expected. David Goldblatt

David Goldblatt (1930 - 2018) was a South African photographer who most notably documented the people, landscapes, and structures of South Africa under apartheid, as well as chronicling its dismantling and legacy after the first free elections in 1994. Goldblatt was born in Randfontein, South Africa and graduated from the University of the Witwatersrand with a degree in commerce. Following the death of

his father in 1962, he sold the family business and devoted himself full-time to photography. Goldblatt's personal work focused on understanding South African's relationships to each other and their physical environment during and after apartheid. His major projects include *On the Mines*, 1973, *Some Afrikaners Photographed*, 1975, *In Boksburg*, 1982, and his series, *Structures*, which he worked on from 1948 to 2018.

In 1989, Goldblatt founded the Market Photography Workshop in Johannesburg. In 1998 he was the first South African to have a solo exhibition at the Museum of Modern Art in New York. Goldblatt died in 2018 in Johannesburg at the age of 87.

Scope and Contents

This collection contains photographic prints, contact sheets, negatives, slides, research material, printed material, correspondence, and other papers by or relating to South African photographer David Goldblatt. Collection Contents

Series I: Personal work, circa 1940s-2016

55.42 linear feet (131 boxes)

This series contains 35mm, 120mm and 4x5 inch black and white and color negatives, contact sheets, and proof prints of Goldblatt's personal work. Work from projects include *Barcelona*, *Boksburg*, *Carlton Centre*, *Ex-offenders*, *Fietas*, *Hillbrow*, *Intersections*, *Johannesburg*, *On the Mines*, *Particulars*, *Shaft Sinker*, *Some Afrikaners*, *Soweto*, *Structures and Land*, and *Transkei*.

David Goldblatt worked in film until 1999, and digitally thereafter. Digital personal work is represented in the archive among the proof prints.

Personal work may also be found in the Corporate work and Magazine work series.

Arranged into three subseries: Negatives, circa 1940s-1999; Contact sheets, circa 1948-2010; and Proof prints, circa 1950-2016.

Negatives	circa 1940s-1999
50.59 linear feet (118 boxes) + 1 broadside	
This subseries contains negatives from Goldblatt's personal photographic work.	
For each negative format, Goldblatt assigned a prefix number, followed by a forward slash, or underscore, and sequential number. Some of these numbers can be referenced in Goldblatt's negative index notebooks, which are located in Boxes 170 and 171.	
Negative formats include 35 mm, indicated by the prefix 3, and followed by a sequential number. After the first 10,000 frames, a sequential prefix letter was given after every 10,000 frames. The series also includes 120 mm negatives, represented by the prefix 2, and followed by a sequential number.	
The series also contains 4 x 5 inch negatives and are represented by the prefix 4, followed by a sequential number. Some 4 x 5 inch negatives include accompanying index cards that record technical and other informational details of the negative. Not all negatives are in sequential order, and some gaps appear throughout the series.	
Material is arranged by negative format, and further arranged by Goldblatt's original organizational system for negatives. Titled projects are located at the end of the series.

The proof prints subseries primarily consists of black and white or color working prints of photographs David Goldblatt identified as personal work. The proof prints include work from projects including *Barcelona*, *Boksburg*, *Fietas*, *Hillbrow*, *Intersections*, *Johannesburg*, *On the Mines*, *Shaft Sinker*, *Some Afrikaners*, *Soweto*, *Structures and Land*, *Transkei*, and others. Also includes some contacts.

The materials listed within this subseries were identified as personal work by the Goldblatt family prior to transfer to the Beinecke Library. Beinecke Library staff made minimal changes to the arrangement of the materials in the process of rehousing materials into archival containers.

Quotation marks indicate that Beinecke Library staff transcribed the description of proof prints from Goldblatt's label. When labels were difficult to read library staff photocopied the label and added it the file.

Magazine work job files include a variety of materials, including negatives, prints, contacts, correspondence, and other papers, documenting Goldblatt's projects for magazines and periodicals. The files document Goldblatt's work for a range of publications, including *Leadership*, *Optima*, *National Geographic*, *The New York Times*, *The Sunday Times*, *Fortune Magazine*, *Observer Magazine*, *The Los Angeles Times*, *Fair Lady Magazine*, and others.

Quotation marks indicate that Beinecke Library staff transcribed a job file title from Goldblatt's label. When labels were difficult to read library staff photocopied the label and added it the file.

David Goldblatt kept his magazine work in envelopes or other enclosures, grouped by commission. The job files maintain that arrangement, roughly in the order in which they were found at the time of receipt.
