Processing Information

Alvin Feinman (1929-2008)

Alvin Feinman was born on November 21, 1929, in New York City. He attended Brooklyn College and the University of Chicago and completed graduate coursework at Yale University before briefly teaching in Yale's Department of Philosophy. Feinman then taught literature at Bennington College, Vermont, from 1969 to 1994. In addition to teaching, Feinman was a poet whose works include *Preambles and Other Poems* (1964). After Feinman's death in 2008, literary critic Harold Bloom published *Corrupted into Song: The Complete Poems of Alvin Feinman*. It contains fifty-seven previously published pieces and thirty-nine unpublished works found within Feinman's collection of manuscripts.

Scope and Contents

The collection contains correspondence, writings, photographs, personal papers, electronic files, and other papers by or relating to Alvin Feinman. Among the correspondents are Feinman's wife, Deborah Dorfman, Harold Bloom, James Geary, Reginald Shepherd, and Danny Myerson. Writings consist of notes and drafts of Feinman's poetry, articles, essays, and other works.
