Processing Information

Collections are processed to a variety of levels, depending on the work necessary to make them usable, their perceived research value, the availability of staff, competing priorities, and whether or not further accruals are expected. The library attempts to provide a basic level of preservation and access for all collections, and does more extensive processing of higher priority collections as time and resources permit.

This collection received a basic level of processing, including rehousing and minimal organization.

John P. Jacob (1957-)

John P. Jacob is an American artist, writer, publisher, photographer, and curator of avant-garde photography. He began his career as an artist working with reproductive media such as photography, rubber stamps, mail art, and artists' books. During the early 1980s, Jacob founded Riding Beggar Press and published the mail art zine *PostHype* and the *International Portfolio of Artists' Photography* (1983-1986), an assembling book project integrating photography, mail art, and book art. His interests in censorship and working with artists from the communist states of Eastern Europe inspired Jacob to travel to Czechoslovakia, East Germany, Hungary, and Poland in the mid-1980s, where he cultivated access to underground circles involved in experimental photography, mail art, and performance art. Jacob also collected photographs by those artists and curated exhibitions of their work in Eastern Europe – the first such transnational exhibits in the Eastern Bloc – and the United States. These exhibitions included "Out of Eastern Europe: Private Photographs," which premiered at the MIT List Visual Arts Center in 1987 before traveling to the Grey Art Gallery at New York University and other American galleries. In 1993, Jacob was appointed Executive Director of the Photographic Resource Center at Boston University. In 2003, he was appointed Founding Director of the Inge Morath Foundation, and from 2011 to 2015 he served as Program Director for the Magnum Foundation's Legacy Program. As of 2022, Jacob is McEvoy Family Curator for Photography at the Smithsonian American Art Museum.

Scope and Contents

The collection contains photographs, artwork, correspondence, printed material, and audiovisual and computer media documenting experimental photography and underground art in Eastern Europe collected by American editor, publisher, and curator John P. Jacob. The bulk of material consists of photographs by artists from East Germany, Poland, Hungary, and Czechoslovakia including Ágnes Eperjesi, Tibor Hajas, László Hegedűs, Gábor Kerekes, Milan Knížák, Matthias Leupold, Géza Perneczky, Karla Sachse, Lenke Szilágyi, Tibor Várnagy, János Vető, and Krystyna Ziach. Images depict everyday life and work in the Eastern Bloc, as well as objects, architecture, and nature. Also included are files related to proposed exhibitions or publications; letters to Jacob from colleagues and friends; artists' books and zines; mixed media, sculpture, lithographs, and other artwork; and offset and silkscreen posters. The collection additionally contains a small amount of photographs by Jacob; Riding Beggar Press project and publication files, including rubber stamps used by Jacob and materials related to *PostHype* and the *International Portfolio of Artists' Photography*; and mail art by artists such as Anna Banana, Ryosuke Cohen, and Ray Johnson.

Collection Contents

Series I: Eastern European Photographs and Art, 1928–2005

This series consists of photographs, artists' books and zines, writings, artwork, posters, and correspondence. Included are materials John P. Jacob collected or solicited for exhibitions and publications, some of which were never realized, such as "Out of Eastern Europe: Private Photography," Second International Portfolio of Artists' Photography, "(VIEWS): Photography from East Germany," and "East German Artists Working in the Tradition of John Heartfield."

Organized into nine subseries: Eastern European Photographs; Proposed Anthology: "Out of Eastern Europe: Private Photography"; Second Portfolio Project: *Second International Portfolio of Artists' Photography*; Proposed Publication: "(VIEWS): Photography from East Germany"; Eastern European and Soviet Artists Books and Zines; Proposed Exhibition: "East German Artists Working in the Tradition of John Heartfield"; Other Artworks; Posters; and Eastern European Correspondence.

Eastern European Photographs

This subseries contains gelatin silver and Cibachrome prints, offset prints, mixed media, and collages collected by Jacob from artists active in Eastern Europe and the Soviet Union in the late 1970s through the mid-1990s. Artists from the German Democratic Republic include Tina Bara, Manfred Butzmann, Guillermo Deisler, Klaus Elle, Thomas Florschuetz, Joseph Huber, Matthias Leupold, Andreas Munstermann, Karla Sachse, Gundula Schulze el Dowy, and Maria Sewcz. Hungarian artists include Ágnes Eperjesi, Tibor Hajas, László 2. Hegedűs, Anna Karpati, Gábor Kerekes, László Lugosi Lugo, Lenke Szilágyi, Tibor Várnagy, and János Vető. Polish artists include Anna Beata Bohdziewicz, Jerzy Caryk, Kuba Pajewski, Josef Robakowski, and Krystyna Ziach. Artists from the USSR and Latvia include Frant's ěisko Infanté, Igor' Makarevich, and October Group. Czech artists include Karel Bartoniček, Milan Knížák, Libor Krejcar, and Miloš Šejn. The subseries also contains photographs of Jacob by or with other artists such as Bohdziewicz, István Halas, Adam Rzepecki, and Várnagy in Budapest the late 1980s.
