Processing Information

Collections are processed to a variety of levels, depending on the work necessary to make them usable, their perceived research value, the availability of staff, competing priorities, and whether or not further accruals are expected. Folder titles appearing in the contents list below are often based on those provided by the creator or previous custodian. Titles have not been verified against the contents of the folders in all cases. Otherwise, folder titles are supplied by staff during initial processing. Separated Materials

Printed material received with the collection was removed for separate cataloging and can be accessed by searching the library's online catalog.

Jonathan Dodd (1936-2017)

Jonathan Dodd (1936-2017) was an American publisher and book collector. Born in Boston in 1936, Dodd spent the majority of his life moving between Connecticut and Rhode Island. After graduating from Yale University in 1958, he joined the publishing house Dodd, Mead, & Company, founded by his great-great grandfather, Moses W. Dodd, in 1839. Dodd eventually assumed the role of president of the company prior to its closure in 1990. He died on January 3, 2017, in Westerly, Rhode Island.

Content Description

The collection contains drafts and print editions of scripts, scores, and other writings by American playwrights Edward Albee and Tennessee Williams, and musical theater writer and composer Stephen Sondheim. Also included is correspondence, contracts, and other materials related to the publication of Sondheim's and Williams's works; photographs; printed materials, such as playbills, souvenir programs, periodicals, and clippings; and notes and inventories related to the collection.

Arrangement

The collection is organized into three series: I. Edward Albee, 1960-2014. II. Stephen Sondheim, 1954-2015. III. Tennessee Williams, 1928-2015.

Collection Contents Series I: Edward Albee, 1960–2014

2.42 linear feet (5 boxes)

This series contains script drafts, photographs, and notes on the works of Edward Albee, as well as printed material including periodicals in which Albee's writings were published, clippings related to performances of his work, and playbills and souvenir programs from various performances.

Organized into two subseries: Writings and Theater Productions, and Printed Materials.

Writings

This subseries contains script drafts of Edward Albee's theatrical works, concept art and photographs for several theatrical productions of his work, and notes and lists compiled by Jonathan Dodd on his collection of Albee materials.
