Processing Information

Collections are processed to a variety of levels, depending on the work necessary to make them usable, their perceived research value, the availability of staff, competing priorities, and whether or not further accruals are expected. The library attempts to provide a basic level of preservation and access for all collections, and does more extensive processing of higher priority collections as time and resources permit.

This collection received a basic level of processing, including rehousing and minimal organization.

Titles have not been verified against the contents of the folders in all cases.

Historical Note

In 1968, workers at the Pirelli tire factory in the Bicocca district of Milan, Italy formed the Comitato unitario di base (CUB), an autonomous, unitary rank-and-file committee independent from the established Italian trade unions. The Pirelli CUB organized a series of wildcat strikes, slowdowns, and stoppages that resulted in a protracted period of labor disputes from September 1968 through December 1969. Other Milanese factories and industries mobilized in the fall of 1969 during a strike wave known as the "Hot Autumn." The major trade unions CGIL, CISL, and UIL became involved with the striking workers, as did the Italian Communist Party (PCI) and other left-wing organizations. Pirelli factory workers continued to organize through the 1970s. Pirelli later closed its Bicocca plant in 1985.

Scope and Contents

The collection contains fliers, handbills, newspapers, and periodicals by or relating to workers on strike at the Pirelli tire plant in Bicocca and other factories in Milan, Italy. Materials document rank-and-file committees, trade unions, and left-wing political organizations involved in the Milanese labor movement from 1968 until the mid-1970s. Included are materials by Confederazione generale italiana del lavoro (CGIL); Confederazione italiana sindacati lavoratori (CISL); Unione italiana del lavoro (UIL); Federazione unitaria CGIL-CISL-UIL; Lotta continua; Partito comunista italiano (PCI); and Partito socialista italiano di unità proletaria (PSIUP).

Organized into two series: I. Fliers, 1956–1976. II. Newspapers, 1962–1974.

Series I: Fliers, 1956–1976

This series contains fliers and handbills created by the Pirelli Comitato unitario di base (CUB) and other trade unions and organizations active in Milan, such as CGIL, CISL, UIL, Lotta continua, PCI, and PSIUP. Other groups represented include unaffiliated groups of workers, works councils, trade union representatives, and workers involved in a trial against Pirelli.
