# **Donald Lyman**

Donald Lyman (1946-) was born in Brooklyn, New York. He studied in History at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill for undergraduate and graduate studies, ultimately receiving his PhD in Diplomatic History, University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill 1976. Lyman worked in the Foreign Service from January 1977 to July 1984 before entering the private sector. He worked for multiple corporations including the Latin American Division, IBM (1984-1999), Ingram Micro (1999-2000) and Sensormatic/Tyco (2001-2009). Since 2009, Lyman has been President of Peregrine Security Inc.
