Included are Huntington's commonplace book, Yale College disputations, indentures, business records, and correspondence. Also present are deeds, indentures, correspondence, and other legal and financial records related to other members of the Huntington family, including Oliver Ellsworth Huntington's father Joseph Huntington (1768-1837); grandfather Andrew Huntington (1745-1824); grandfather Joseph Carew (1738-1818); Jedediah Huntington (1743-1818); Jonathan Huntington (1696-1773); Joseph Huntington (1661-1747); Joshua Huntington (1751-1821); Roger Huntington (1757-1835); Roswell Huntington (1763-1836); Governor Samuel Huntington (1731-1796); Jabez Williams Huntington (1788-1847); Ebenezer Devotion (1740-1829); and Eunice Huntington Devotion (1742-1827). The collection also contains an account book, political petitions, newspaper clippings, printed material, and other documents concerning social, political, and religious life in Norwich, Connecticut. A small quantity of twentieth century material relates to Oliver Ellsworth Huntington's grandson Ellsworth Huntington, primarily correspondence and newspaper clippings.

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## Biographical / Historical

Oliver Ellsworth Huntington (1802-1877) was a pharmacist and merchant in Connecticut, New York, and Ohio. He was born in Norwich, Connecticut to Joseph Huntington (1768-1837) and Eunice Carew Huntington (1769-1848). Huntington graduated from Yale College in 1825 and went into business with his

partner William E. Dodge (1805-1883) in New York. He later moved to Ohio and was active in local politics, commerce, and religious activities. Oliver Ellsworth Huntington married his first wife, Mary Ann Strong Huntington (1806-1840) in 1830 and his second wife, Eunice Kimberly Hitchcock Huntington (1825-1910) in 1854. He had four children with his first wife. His son, Henry Strong Huntington, also attended Yale and became a Congregational minister. Oliver Ellsworth Huntington died in 1877 in Ohio.

The Huntington family descends from Simon Huntington (1583-1633) and Margaret Barrett Huntington (circa 1590s-1665 or 1666). Prominent members of the family include Samuel Huntington (1731-1796), the first governor of Connecticut; Jabez Huntington (1719-1786) (Yale 1741), merchant and Connecticut politician; and Ellsworth Huntington (1876-1947), a professor of geography at Yale and president of the Ecological Society of America, Association of American Geographers, and the American Eugenics Society.

Biographical information in this note is primarily drawn from *The Huntington Family in America: A Genealogical Memoir of the Known Descendants of Simon Huntington from 1633 to 1915* (Hartford, Connecticut: Huntington Family Association, 1915).
