SUMMARY: The Bena Frank Mayer papers document Mayer's life as an artist, art teacher, and cofounder, with her husband Ralph, of the Artists Technical Research Institute. Her papers contain correspondence; biographical materials; records of artworks including photographic documentation and lists of works; sketches and paintings; diaries; publications; and auction and exhibition catalogs. Formats includes scrapbooks; framed photographs with glass, cased photographs and leather locket photographs, slides, negatives and transparencies; artwork including charcoal and pencil sketches and watercolors; and etching plates. Materials date from circa 1880s to 1991. Subjects include the Frank family history in Wyoming; Frank's artistic and familial networks; her artistic career, including exhibition history and examples of her work; and her working partnership with her husband Ralph in researching and providing information on technical aspects of art materials and methods.

Biographical / Historical

Bena (Virginia) Frank Mayer was born on May 31, 1898, in Norfolk, Virginia, the daughter of Matilda Metzger Frank and Isaac Frank, and younger sister of Malcolm Gluck Frank (1891-1918). In the first few years of Mayer's life her family moved from Virginia to Newcastle, Wyoming where her father attempted to establish himself as a bank president. Following Mayer's childhood in Wyoming, her family moved back to Virginia before relocating to New York City in 1914.

In New York, Mayer enrolled in the Cooper Union and the Art Students League to pursue her visual art education before privately studying with Gifford Beal, Stuart Davis, George Luks, and Cecelia Beaux, in Paris. Mayer supported herself as a portrait painter throughout the 1920s, using the money she earned to finance an extended study trip to France, Spain and the Balearic Islands. Her work received many awards, including silver and bronze medals while a student at Cooper Union, first watercolor prize from the National Association of Women Artists (1951), the Marcia Tucker Award, and the Lena Newcastle Memorial Prize (1959), among others. She was also the recipient of numerous artist residencies including the Yaddo Fellow award (1956), the Huntington Hartford Foundation award (1957), the MacDowell Colony (1960 and 1966), as well as the Beaux Arts resident award at Hydra, Greece (1964). Her work was shown in the Carnegie International exhibition, the Whitney Museum of American Art, the University of Bangor

(Maine), the Norfolk Museum of Art. She had solo shows at Simon's Rock in Great Barrington (1972) and the Yale School of Art (1990).

She met materials technologist and artist Ralph Mayer at a small social event hosted for young people at Temple Imanuel in New York. The two were married on July 25, 1927 in Manhattan. Together, Ralph and Bena Frank Mayer researched and edited several artist's reference books, including *The Artists' Handbook of Materials and Techniques*, first published in 1940. Their work together would eventually lead to the founding of the Artists Technical Research Institute (ATRI) in 1959, with the support of businessman and philanthropist Huntington Hartford. In addition to serving as co-founder and vice president of ATRI, Mayer also served as a board member for the National Association of Women Artists, the American Society of Contemporary Artists, and was twice president of the New York Society of Women Artists.

In 1990, Bena Frank Mayer established the Ralph Mayer Learning Center at the Yale University School of Art to house materials related to the Artists Technical Research Institute and support the continued study of artists' materials and techniques in the fields of painting and drawing. Steven Sheehan, the first director of the Mayer Center, edited and revised *The Artists' Handbook* for its 1991 edition. Mayer died in New York on August 22, 1991.

Scope and Contents

The Bena Frank Mayer papers document her personal and professional life and family history. Materials date from the 1880s until her death in 1991, and detail her artistic career, professional affiliations, and role in the establishment of the Artists Technical Research Institute (ATRI) with her husband Ralph Mayer, as well as her stewardship of his work following his death in 1979.

The collection consists of original works of art, sketches, studies, and reference photographs, as well as extensive diaries and autobiographical writings detailing her travels in Europe, her thoughts on marriage and domesticity, and her psychoanalysis. The collection also includes correspondence, photographs, and other documents related to Bena Frank Mayer's immediate and extended family, as well as that of her late husband, providing a fuller biographical portrait of her upbringing between Wyoming and Virginia. There are also numerous examples of work and written reflections on her time as an art student in New York in the 1910s to the 1920s. Membership lists, group exhibition catalogs and brochures document her involvement with many artistic organizations in New York.

Collection Contents

Series I: Artwork, 1914-circa 1991

This series contains original artworks, including drawings, sketches, watercolors, pastels, studies, as well as some reproductions of oil paintings produced by both Bena Frank and Ralph Mayer. Subjects represented in the collection include: urban scenes in and around New York City, landscapes, portraits (both commissioned and of the artist's friends and relatives), and cats and other animals. Much of the works present are in the form of sketchbooks, some of which document Bena Frank's travels in Europe between the 1940s and the early 1980s. The collection also contains some early examples of Bena Frank's artistic explorations and development from the 1920s shortly after completing her formal art education and before her marriage to Ralph Mayer.

The portion of this series pertaining specifically to Ralph Mayer contains numerous portfolios of drawings and studies, as well as color notes, reference photographs, sketchbooks, and some exhibition loan documents for Ralph Mayer's paintings. Examples of Ralph Mayer's work in the collection similarly represent subjects including urban scenes and landscapes in and around New York, as well as some produced during European travels between the 1950s and 1960s.

Series I is organized into two subseries: Bena Frank Mayer artwork and Ralph Mayer artwork.

Series II: Biographical Materials, 1887-1990

The majority of this series is composed of Bena Frank Mayer's writing in the forms of poetry and prose, diaries (including reflections on her experience of psychoanalysis), travelogues, unpublished memoir drafts, notes on art, and other unpublished writings gathering her thoughts on feminism, marriage, and homemaking. Additionally present are diaries, wills, and news clippings related to other members of Bena Frank and Ralph Mayer's families, as well as miscellaneous personal documents such as Bena Frank's wedding certificate and anniversary materials. Family photographs may be found in Series IV.

Series II is organized into three subseries: General biographical materials, Family papers, and memoir materials.
