SUMMARY: This collection contains the papers of scholar and spiritual and religious practitioner Lex Hixon (Nur al-Jerrahi) and dates from the 1940s to the 2010s. The papers document Hixon's study of religion, as well as his work as a writer, radio host and religious leader. The bulk of these papers relate to Hixon's writing and study of Hinduism, Zen and Tibetan Buddhism, Sufism and Eastern Orthodox Christianity.

Processing Information

This collection was arranged by Hixon's family prior to transfer to Yale Divinity Library Special Collections. Many of the original folder titles created by the family have been retained. Materials were rehoused into archival legal sized folders and archival boxes. Additional contextual information provided by the family was retained, and folder titles were copied and added to the corresponding folders. In some cases, folders were split into multiple folders to simplify contents. In cases where the title was provided with no additional contextual information was provided, the folder was not photocopied.

Biographical / Historical

Alexander (Lex) Paul Hixon Jr (Nur al-Jerrahi) was a scholar, writer and radio host, who practiced Sufism, Hinduism, Zen and Tibetan Buddhism, and Eastern Orthodox Christianity. He was born on December 25th, 1941 in Pasadena, California. In 1954, he enrolled at the Hotchkiss School, a private boarding and day school in Lakeville, Connecticut. After graduating from Hotchkiss, Hixon went on to study at Yale University, focusing on literature and philosophy, particularly the works of Søren Kierkegaard. In 1966, he began studying at the New School for Social Research. In 1967, he entered the Religion Department at Columbia University in a joint program with the Union Theological Seminary. He wrote his master's thesis on Ramana Maharshi, a 20th century Indian sage, and his PhD dissertation on the important Advaita Vedanta text Gaudapada Karika. He graduated with his PhD in 1976.

In 1971, Hixon began broadcasting a weekly radio show entitled *In the Spirit* on the alternative radio station WBAI in New York City. He interviewed spiritual practitioners from various religious traditions, as well as thought leaders in the burgeoning New Age tradition. In 1980, WBAI changed the name to *Body/Mind/Spirit* which aired until 1984.

Hixon was a member of several religious and spiritual traditions. Inspired by the teachings of Ramakrishna, Hixon believed all religions to be true. During his studies at Yale, Hixon traveled to South Dakota to visit his roommate Sam Deloria's family. Hixon met Sam's father Vine Deloria Sr, a Sioux Native American and Episcopal priest, who introduced Hixon to both Dakota and Episcopal religious practices. Beginning in 1966, Hixon spent six years studying Vedanta philosophy and meditation practices under Swami Nikhilananda, a senior monk and scholar of the Ramakrishna order of India. In 1976, Hixon began practicing Tibetan Buddhism under Lama Tomo Geshe Rinpoche. In 1979, Hixon met Sheikh Muzafer Ozak and began studying Sufism, a branch of Islam. Hixon accompanied Sheikh Ozak on Hajj in 1980 and became the head of the Nur Ashki-Jerrahi order. Sheikh Ozak gave Hixon the name Nur al-Jerrahi. In 1983, Hixon began studying with Father Alexander Schmemmann at St. Vladimir's Seminary and was accepted into the Orthodox church. Hixon was also immersed in the practices of Zen Buddhism, and studied with Roshi Tetsungen Bernie (Bernard) Glassman.

Hixon's experiences with and studies of each tradition laid the foundation for each of his books. Hixon published eight books throughout his life: *Coming Home: The Experience of Enlightenment in Sacred Traditions* (1978), *The Heart of the Qur'an* (1988), *Great Swan: Meetings with Ramakrishna* (1992), *Atom from the Sun of Knowledge* (1993), *Mother of the Buddhas: Meditation on the Prajnaparamita Sutra* (1993), *Mother of the Universe: Visions of the Goddess and Tantric Hymns of Enlightenment* (1994), *Living Buddha*

Zen (1995), *101 Diamonds: From the Oral Tradition of the Glorious Messenger Muhammad* (2001). Hixon was a frequent lecturer, guest speaker and taught at the New School for Social Research, the Naropa Summer Institute and the Omega Summer Institute. In addition to his spiritual and religious work, Hixon studied flamenco guitar with Carlos Montoya and with sarod player Vasant Rai.

Hixon was involved in various religious organizations. In 1980, Hixon began serving as the head of the Nur Ashki-Jerrahi Order's lodges in Mexico City and New York City, filling in for Sheikh Ozak before taking over fully in 1985 on the occasion of the Sheikh's death. In the 1984, Hixon and a group of other American students of Vedanta founded the Sarada Ramakrishna Vivekananda (SRV) Order, an organization dedicated to public service and the spread of Ramakrishna's teachings. Hixon served on the board until his death in 1995. Hixon was also involved in founding the Zen Community of New York with Roshi Tetsungen Bernie Glassman, and served on the board of directors.

Hixon was diagnosed with cancer in 1994 and died in 1995 on All Souls Day and Jagaddhatri Puja (a Hindu festival celebrating the Divine Mother, goddess Durga), at his home in New York.

Content Description

The Lex Hixon (Nur Al-Jerrahi) papers pertain to Hixon's work as an author, radio host, spiritual seeker, religious practitioner and leader. The materials date from the 1940s to the 2010s, with a majority of the materials dating from 1960s-1990s. The materials include manuscripts, printed materials, correspondence, audiovisual materials and photographs. The collection documents Hixon's studies at the Hotchkiss School, Yale, and Columbia and includes schoolwork and essays. This collection contains materials relating to Hixon's studies in Hinduism, Advaita, Zen and Tibetan Buddhism, the Orthodox Eastern Church and Sufism, as well as materials pertaining to religious pilgrimages and rites. In addition to manuscripts and drafts of published work, the collection contains unpublished manuscripts as well as poetry written by Hixon throughout his life. Correspondence, which is present throughout the collection, pertains to the publishing and marketing of his books, correspondence with others on the spiritual path, as well as with spiritual teachers, including Sheikh Muzaffer Ozak, Swami Nikhilananda and Vine Deloria Sr. Additionally, this collection contains administrative files and audio recordings relating to *In the Spirit*, Hixon's radio show on Pacifica Radio station WBAI in New York, New York. This collection also documents Hixon's involvement with various religious organizations up until his death in 1995, including the Zen Community of New York, the SRV Association, and the Nur Ashki-Jerrahi Order of Sufi lodges in New York, New York and Mexico City, Mexico, for which he served as Sheikh.

Series I *In the Spirit* (1970-2010): This series contains materials relating to Hixon's work with WBAI and his radio program *In the Spirit*, which was renamed *Body/Mind/Spirit* in 1980. Materials include correspondence, program lists, interviews of Hixon by others, as well as lectures given by Hixon. This series also contains material relating to the In the Spirit Foundation, the Mind-Body-Spirit Festival, as well as *Free Spirit: A Wholistic Directory* created by Hixon in 1979. Also contains correspondence relating to the creation of *Conversations in the Spirit: Lex Hixon's WBAI 'In the Spirit' Interviews*, edited by Sheila Hixon. Additionally, this series contains digitized copies of *In the Spirit* and *Body/Mind/Spirit*.

Series II Writing (1959-2018): This series contains materials relating to Hixon's writings, including published and unpublished manuscripts, early drafts and edited manuscripts. This series also contains correspondence relating to the publishing and promotion of his books, correspondence with religious leaders and notable recipients of Hixon's books. This series includes mailing lists, book orders, as well as files relating to the subject of each book. This series also contains reviews, interviews, and articles and shorter works written by Hixon, printed materials, either produced by Hixon, or containing works by Hixon, as well as a collection of Hixon's early fiction writings. This series also contains self-published books of poetry, incomplete poems, as well as publishing contracts and agreements.

Series III Personal Papers (1949-2010): This series is comprised of the personal papers of Hixon, such as correspondence, including correspondence from Vine Deloria Sr, papers from Hixon's high school, undergraduate and graduate schooling, Hixon's memorial service in December, 1995, materials from other projects undertaken by Hixon and books from Hixon's library. Materials include correspondence, notebooks, drafts of Hixon's PhD dissertation and Master's thesis, school essays and notes, audiocassettes of talks given by Hixon, and photographs. This series also contains collages, transcripts from conferences, and materials relating to Hixon's musical studies with Carlos Montoya and Vasant Rai.

Series IV Religious Organizations (1970-2013): This series documents Hixon's involvement with three organizations: the Zen Community of New York, where he served on the board, the Sarada Ramakrishna Vivekananda (SRV) Center, which he founded in conjunction with other American vedantists, and the Nur Ashki-Jerrahi Sufi order, where he served as Sheikh Nur Al-Jerrahi until his death in 1995. Materials in this series include correspondence, clippings, projects undertaken by Hixon and the organizations, talks given by Hixon, printed materials, newsletters and Sufi materials in Spanish.
