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## History

The Book-of-the-Month Club (BOMC) was founded in 1926 by Harry Scherman (1887-1969) in partnership with Maxwell Sackheim (1890-1982) and Robert K. Haas (1890-1964). Created to satisfy a perceived demand for quality literature that could not be met outside of urban centers, it was one of a number of direct-mail clubs developed in the 1920s, including the Literary Guild and Dollar Book Club. The BOMC went public in 1947, though the Scherman family maintained a controlling interest until sale of their shares in 1977 to Time Inc.

The BOMC sold new releases to its membership through recommendations published in a monthly catalog. Pre-publication manuscripts were submitted to the BOMC for review and were considered through a tiered system of in-house and outside editors culminating in an editorial board, referred to as judges in BOMC literature, that met monthly to consider vetted submissions.

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## Scope and Contents

The collection consists of proofs and "first reader reports" that document a component of the selection process for titles that became Book-of-the-Month Club recommendations. The proofs are pre-publication copies of manuscripts, used by Book-of-the-Month Club judges to select titles. They can be located in Series I and Series III.

The reports comprise reviews by in-house editors and outside readers of manuscripts under consideration for publication. They were written by a wide variety of individuals including Rosemary Benet, Basil Davenport, Elizabeth Wynne Easton, Roger Pippett, John Sherry, Russell Thacher, Ralph Thompson, and Leon Wilson.

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## Arrangement

Organized into three series: I. Manuscripts, circa 1959-1978. II. First-reader Reports, circa 1946-1962. III. Additional Manuscripts (July 2000 Acquisition), circa 1951-1979.

## Collection Contents

### Series I: Manuscripts, circa 1959-1978

(36 boxes)

The series consists of pre-publication copies, mostly galley proofs, of manuscripts submitted to the Book-of-the-Month Club to be considered for selection as a featured title. The manuscripts were most likely prepared and distributed for judges and many have stickers affixed, designating the copy as an "A" book. Although these galleys often contain editorial notes in the reproduction, they are generally unmarked by the readers at the Book-of-the-Month Club.

Additional titles are listed in Series III, which consists of the July 2000 acquisition of this collection.

**Series II: First-Reader Reports, circa 1946-1962***(14 boxes)*

The First Reader Reports consist of typescript reviews of manuscripts, written by a combination of in-house editors and outside readers. The reports helped the Book-of-the-Month Club select titles from among manuscripts submitted by publishers and individuals. The reports are typed on a given form stipulating the institutional expectations for the reports, with specific questions guiding the reader to determine whether or not the given manuscript should be considered by the judges at the monthly meetings.

The reports were written by a wide variety of reviewers, including Rosemary Benet, Basil Davenport, Elizabeth Wynne Easton, Roger Pippett, John Sherry, Russell Thacher, Ralph Thompson, and Leon Wilson.

The series is arranged loosely chronologically, with two pre-designated categories, "African diaspora history and literature" and "American literature" filed at the beginning. Reviews of books in these topics are also included among the chronologically arranged materials.
