Processing Information

Preliminary processing was done to the Nelson Hayes papers at an unknown date. During reprocessing of the collection in 2010, the arrangement of correspondence and writings was largely preserved in Series I and II respectively; journals were moved from the writings into a separate series (Series III); unsorted writings were added at the end of the alphabetical sequence in the Writings series (Series II); and subject files were moved into a new Personal Papers series (Series IV).

Nelson Hayes (1903-)

Nelson Hayes was born October 9, 1903, in Trépiéd, Pas de Calais, France, son of Chester Coleman and Henrietta (Andrews) Hayes. He attended the Hotchkiss School and Yale (class of 1925) before marrying Emmy Katherine Clason on December 28, 1925. Hayes's professional employment included work as a secretary and assistant treasurer at Lockwood Manufacturing Co. in South Norwalk, CT (1925-1930), a real estate broker in South Norwalk, CT (1934-1955), and an investment executive in Roxbury, VT (1955-).

Scope and Contents

The Nelson Hayes papers contain correspondence, writings, journals, and other materials documenting the personal and professional life of author Nelson Hayes. Materials throughout the collection also document Hayes's special interest in the Caribbean. For example, subject files located in the Correspondence and Personal Papers series, writings, and journals contain clippings, personal observations and commentary, and photographs relating to the Caribbean. Specific writings set in the Caribbean include "Caribbean Junket", *Dildo Cay*, and "Spanceled". Otherwise, the bulk of the general correspondence in the collection is with Hayes's wife, mother, and two daughters. Correspondence relating to writings consists chiefly of letters from editors about novels, short stories, articles, and other writings. The Writings series contains research files and drafts for various forms of work, such as articles, poems, short stories, and published and unpublished novels. There are typescript copies of Hayes's journals, including research for writings, lists of illustrations, and indices, dating from 1950 to 1970; journals are bound with original correspondence, photographs, and clippings dating from 1922 to 1973. Personal Papers contain a calendar, clippings, and notebooks.

Arrangement

Organized into four series: I. Correspondence, 1915-1973. II. Writings, 1920-1973. III. Journals, undated. IV. Personal Papers, 1971.

Collection Contents

Series I: Correspondence, 1915-1973

6.67 linear feet (16 boxes)

General correspondence includes family, personal, and professional correspondence. The bulk of the correspondence is with Hayes's wife ("Emmy"), mother, and two daughters ("Ilse" and "Larrier"). There are also subject files on "Public Issues" and the "Virgin Islands" containing correspondence and clippings.

Correspondence Relating to Writings, arranged alphabetically, consists chiefly of letters from editors about novels, short stories, articles, and other writings. There is also correspondence with literary agents and fan mail. The largest group of letters relates to Hayes's best-known novel *Dildo Cay*.

The correspondence contains some newspaper clippings, notes, and writings.

Additional correspondence can be found among the journals in Series III.

Organized into two subseries: General Correspondence and Correspondence Relating to Writings.

Series II: Writings, 1920-1973*5.63 linear feet (14 boxes)*

Series II, Writings, contains research files and drafts for various forms of work, such as articles, poems, short stories, and published and unpublished novels. Aside from early notes and poems dating from Hayes's time as a student at Yale, most writings date from the early 1930s to early 1970s.

Series III, Journals, contains typescript copies of Hayes's journals covering the period from 1950 to 1970. Journals include research for writings, lists of illustrations, and indices, and are bound with original correspondence, photographs, and clippings dating from 1922 to 1973. Volumes are numbered in chronological order, with individual titles listed in folder headings below. The dates of the period covered are given in brackets, though inscriptions suggest that copies may have been made at a later date.
