Processing Information

Collections are processed to a variety of levels, depending on the work necessary to make them usable, their perceived research value, the availability of staff, competing priorities, and whether or not further accruals are expected. The library attempts to provide a basic level of preservation and access for all collections, and does more extensive processing of higher priority collections as time and resources permit.

The collection received preliminary processing at the time of acquisition. Further organization, rehousing, and description were carried out in 2012. Various acquisitions associated with the collection have not been merged and organized as a whole. Each acquisition is described separately in the contents list below, identified by a unique call number and titled according to month and year of acquisition.

Information included in the Description of Papers note and Collection Contents section is drawn from information supplied with the collection and from an initial survey of the contents. Folder titles appearing in the contents list below are often based on those provided by the creator or previous custodian. Titles have not been verified against the contents of the folders in all cases. Otherwise, folder titles are supplied by staff during basic processing.

This finding aid may be updated periodically to account for new acquisitions to the collection and/or revisions in arrangement and description.

Vincent McHugh (1904-1983)

Vincent McHugh was an American poet, novelist, and editor. He served as editor-in-chief and Technical Director of the New York office of the Federal Writers Project during the Depression, was a staff writer for *The New Yorker* in the late 1930's and was a writer-director for the Office of War Information Films. He published five novels, including *The Victory* (1947), *I am Thinking of My Darling* (1943), and *Caleb Catlum's America* (1936). His published poetry collections include *Alpha: The Mutabilities* (1958); *The Blue Hen's Chickens, Poems, Verses, Blues* (1947); and *Old Friends from Far Away* (1980), an English translation of classical Mandarin poems. He was married to Patricia McHugh and had no children.

Scope and Contents

The Vincent McHugh Papers document the professional and personal life of poet, novelist, and editor Vincent McHugh. The papers consist of personal and professional correspondence, drafts of writings,

professional papers, journals, notebooks, personal papers, photographs, sound recordings, drawings, and a scrapbook, spanning the years 1933 to 1983.

This material is organized under eight headings: Correspondence, Writings, Professional Papers, Personal Papers, Journals and Notebooks, Photographs, and Sound Recordings.

Correspondence contains personal and professional correspondence between Vincent McHugh and various individuals. Writings are autograph manuscript and typescript drafts of various writings, including McHugh's *Alpha: The Mutabilities*, *The Victory*, *Primer of the Novel*, Chinese poetry translations, poetry, reviews, as well as research material for writings on various topics, and other writings. Professional Papers contain lecture, course and teaching materials; and materials relating to McHugh's work with The Works Progress Administration, Office of War Information Films, Writer's War Board, Paramount Pictures, and other professional affiliations. Personal Papers include financial and travel material and other personal papers. Journals and Notebooks contain McHugh's personal journals and notebooks with writings and other notes. Photographs are snapshots of personal and professional subjects. Sound Recordings include various readings of McHugh's poetry and dictation of his autobiography.
