Nancy Cole

Nancy Cole is an American actor who, during the 1960s and 1970s, regularly took on the persona of Gertrude Stein and performed a one-woman show, *Gertrude Stein's Gertrude Stein*, based on Stein's original writings.

Scope and Contents

The collection consists of correspondence, including letters from Kay Boyle, Donald Gallup, Robert Haas, Marcel Marceau and the artist Henry Miller; photographs; clippings; printed material; sound recordings; and manuscripts relating to the production of Nancy Cole's one-woman show, *Gertrude Stein's Gertrude Stein*, and other projects, including *One of Each*.
