Yale University records are arranged and described at the accession level by the creating office. The University Archives creates collection level descriptive records, but typically does no further arrangement and description at the accession level.

Biographical / Historical

The Sheffield Scientific School, like the Graduate School, had its origins in the Department of Philosophy and the Arts established in 1847. It was given its name by the Yale Corporation in 1861 in recognition of the support of Joseph Earl Sheffield of New Haven who not only gave the first building but also provided funds for its equipment and development. Subsequently he made other gifts and finally bequeathed to a corporation, the Board of Trustees of the Sheffield Scientific School, a substantial endowment which was to be held and administered by the Trustees for the benefit of the natural, physical, and mathematical sciences in Yale University.

Sheffield was one of the first schools of higher education in the United States to devote its curriculum specifically to scientific training. The School played an important part in the evolution of American higher learning from the strict classical model of education to a curriculum which encompassed a liberal scientific education.

The faculty of the School conducted graduate as well as undergraduate courses in the sciences and engineering until 1919 when the former were discontinued. In 1932, engineering instruction was transferred to the newly organized Yale School of Engineering. In 1945 Sheffield resumed its original function of teaching at the graduate level. Under the general administration of the Graduate School, its faculty furnished instruction to graduate students in the sciences and mathematics who were M.A. and Ph.D. candidates. In 1956 the School's functions were absorbed by the Graduate School. The Directors of Sheffield Scientific School were: George Jarvis Brush, 1872-1898; Russell Henry Chittenden, 1898-1922; Charles Hyde Warren, 1922-1945; Edmund Ware Linnott, 1945-1956.

Collection Contents

Series I: Trustees and Governing Board Records, 1871-1967

Series I contains the records of the Sheffield Scientific School's policy setting and administrative bodies - the Board of Trustees, responsible for overseeing property and finances, and the Governing Board, responsible for curriculum development, faculty appointments and other academic matters.

The Trustees Records 1871-1967 is comprised of minutes of the Executive Committee meetings and the Board of Trustees meetings, financial papers, including Treasurer's reports, Auditor's reports, funds and bequest material and correspondence.

The Governing Board Records 1872-1956 consists of a complete set of minutes. Included in these volumes are recommendations for faculty appointments and promotions, committee reports, curriculum approval and recommendations of candidates for degrees.

The materials in Series I are grouped into sections by administrative unit: the Board of Trustees, the Executive Committee and the Governing Board. The materials within each section are arranged chronologically.

Series II: Faculty Minutes, circa 1852-1945

Series II, FACULTY MINUTES, 1860-1945, documents the Sheffield Scientific School's day-to-day academic and student related activities. The minutes contain, among other things, information on curriculum, catalogue descriptions, teaching schedules, examination results, minutes of the class instructors meetings, action taken with students in academic trouble and student discipline.

The Sheffield Scientific School faculty was originally called the Board of Instructors. Beginning on October 24, 1932, the Sheffield Scientific School faculty met jointly with the School of Engineering faculty. It should be noted that these minutes are not complete to 1956 and that gaps exist in the time span represented.

Materials include correspondence, policy statements, Yale University reorganization material, early admissions material, personnel records, several histories of the Sheffield Scientific School, and information regarding the effects of the two world wars on the Sheffield Scientific School. There is no material from the George Jarvis Brush administration (1872-1898).

The Sheffield Scientific School served as the land grant agricultural college for Connecticut from 1863-1893. The primary function of the Appointing Board and the State Board of Visitors was to fill vacancies in state scholarships to the Sheffield Scientific School. The minutes of the Appointing Board meetings record routine business and procedures as well as choice of scholars and awarded funds. Official Notices consists of forms and notices issued from the Directors and/or Registrar's Offices from 1860s- 1940s. Materials include announcements, exam schedules, meal forms, notices of school closings, and commencement activities.

Director Russell H. Chittenden's correspondence is arranged alphabetically by correspondent or subject of the correspondence. Note: for a list of Russell Henry Chittenden selected correspondents see Appendix I. These papers contain one major subsection - World War I Activities - organized alphabetically by subject. The papers of Directors Charles Hyde Warren and Edmund W. Sinnott are combined in one file arranged alphabetically by correspondent or subject. These papers contain one major subgroup - Personnel Records - arranged alphabetically by person or department.

The Annual Reports are arranged chronologically. Committee on the Selection of a Successor to Sheffield Scientific School Director Russell H. Chittenden, Appointing Board Records and Semi-Centennial Celebration Records are organized by form. Centennial Celebration Records are organized alphabetically with one major subsection - the Committee on Arrangements. The Student Register and Official Notices are arranged chronologically.
