Tom Morin (MFA '68) is a graphic designer who worked at the Xerox Design Center and Westinghouse before becoming a principal at several important design firms.

Scope and Contents

In addition to examples of Morin's own work, the collection also includes design specimens collected by Morin to represent the many designers and firms he considers to be influences.
