SUMMARY: The papers reflect Bouhuys' professional career as a specialist in lung disease. He was active in many organizations and was called upon as a consultant by legislative committees, trade unions, and manufacturers' groups both in the United States and Great Britain. The papers consist of correspondence, 1963-1979; research and organization files, 1951-1979; writings, 1965-1979; and a small amount of personal papers, 1957-1979. These papers form part of the Contemporary Medical Care and Health Policy Collection.

Arend Bouhuys (1925-1979): physician; worked at University Hospital, Utrecht (Netherlands), 1948-1952; at University Hospital, Amsterdam, 1952-1955; at Beatrixoord Tuberculosis Clinic, Netherlands, 1955-1957; professor, University Hospital, Leiden, 1959-1962; professor, Emory University, 1962-1964; professor at Yale University, 1964-1979; director of Yale Lung Research Center, 1971-1979.

Scope and Contents

The Arend Bouhuys Papers date from 1951 until 1979, and consist of correspondence, 1963-79; research and organization files, 1951-1979; writings, 1965-79; and personal papers, 1957-79. A portion of the papers are in Dutch. Box 21, which contains patient records, is restricted until 2029.

The papers were received from Fenna (Mrs. Arend) Bouhuys in 1981.
