Hoyt Curtiss Pease was born on June 24, 1911, in New Britain, Connecticut, and was a graduate of the Class of 1934, Sheffield Scientific School, Yale University. While at Yale, Pease was a member of the 150-pound crew squad, assistant manager and manager of the university crew, and secretary and treasurer of the Yale Corinthian Yacht Club. He served as regatta chairman from 1940-1974.
