## **Biographical / Historical**

David Cushman Twichell was born on October 9, 1874, in Hartford, Connecticut, to Julia Harmony and Joseph Hopkins Twichell. He was a graduate of Yale College (B.A.1898) and the Columbia University (M.D. 1903). He married Ella Goodridge Cooke in 1907. Twitchell died on August 12, 1924, in Keene, New York.
