Biographical / Historical

Ralph Heyward Isham was born in New York City on July 2, 1890. He attended Cornell University (1908), Yale College (1910-1911), and New York Law School. He served in the British army during World War I, and following the armistice in November of 1918 he was named head of an intelligence unit which investigated and suppressed Bolshevik activities among military personnel. For his army service he was made a Commander of the Order of the British Empire, and retired at the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. Isham returned to New York City and was associated with a number of business concerns including Trumbull Securities Corporation, of which he was president. His avid collecting of James Boswell papers resulted in the private publication of *The Private Papers of James Boswell from Malahide Castle in the Collection of Lt.-Colonel Ralph Heyward Isham (1928-1934)* in eighteen volumes. He died in New York City in 1955.

Scope and Contents

The Ralph Heyward Isham Papers contain correspondence, topical files, business and financial documents, photographs and printed material which document Isham's British army service and his collecting and publishing of the James Boswell papers. The papers were donated to Manuscripts and Archives by Jonathan Isham in 1986. The three linear feet of papers are arranged in two series: I. BRITISH INTELLIGENCE FILES and II. BOSWELL PAPERS FILES.

Series I, BRITISH INTELLIGENCE FILES, consists of materials relating to Isham's work as head of a British army intelligence unit known as A-2, G.H.Q. When British soldiers were not demobilized immediately after the armistice in November of 1918, some disgruntled troops conducted "strikes" and refused to parade or obey orders. Isham's work in dealing with disaffection among troops at his command was brought to the attention of Field Marshall William Robertson who appointed Isham to his staff in 1918 to investigate and suppress Bolshevik activities which were believed to be responsible for the strikes. In order to assist him in accomplishing these goals, Robertson authorized the formation of the A-2 branch at General Headquarters. Isham was named director with a major and six other officers under his command. Through undercover investigations of suspected Bolsheviks and lectures to troops on the dangers of Bolshevism, the A-2 Branch was successful in ending and preventing strikes among servicemen. Subsequently, the A-2 Branch was placed within the Home Office so that Isham could conduct investigations and take disciplinary action against nonmilitary British citizens who were believed to be involved in traitorous activities.

Materials within the series include administrative correspondence and memoranda; correspondence between Isham and his agents; investigative reports by agents on individuals, organizations, and locations; records of the lecture program which describe the units addressed and impressions of troop morale; printed material; and several photographs.

Series II, BOSWELL PAPERS FILES, consists of correspondence, business and financial records, printed material and photographs related to Isham's collecting and publishing of the papers of James Boswell and Isham's involvement in the literary arena. Correspondents include the Talbots de Malahide from whom Isham obtained Boswell material; William Rudge, the printer of the eighteen-volume *The Private Papers of James Boswell from Malahide Castle in the Collection of Lt.-Colonel Ralph Heyward Isham*; Charles Getts, who, as Isham's agent arranged the collector's speaking engagements, and numerous individual and institutional subscribers to the *Papers*. The bulk of the business and financial records consists of invoices, receipts, inventories, sales accounts, and subscriber lists from William Rudge.
