SUMMARY: Research materials for a history of the Protestant Episcopal Church, drafts of articles written for the *Historical Magazine of the Protestant Episcopal Church* and other publications, and for several books on church history. Also included is an extensive autograph collection of over 300 letters of Protestant Episcopal bishops. Of particular interest in the research materials are correspondence and documents of Bishop Alfred Lee and others relating to missionary work in Mexico between 1875-1915. Also in the papers is a collection of sermons (1765-1931), a scrapbook compiled by Chorley about the general convention of 1913, and a brief diary for the year of 1932.

Scope and Contents

The history of the Protestant Episcopal Church in America is the subject of the E. Clowes Chorley Papers. Chorley was a historiographer of the Protestant Episcopal Church, and the founder and first editor in 1932 of the *Historical Magazine of the Protestant Episcopal Church*. A sizeable portion of his papers consists of research materials and drafts of articles written for the *Magazine* and other publications, and for several books on church history. Autographs and writings of Protestant Episcopal bishops and others important in the history of the church, which Chorley collected, make up the remainder of his papers.

The E. Clowes Chorley Papers have been divided into three series: AUTOGRAPH COLLECTION, RESEARCH PAPERS, and WRITINGS. In the first series are over 300 letters and autographs of Protestant Episcopal bishops and others, arranged alphabetically. Series II contains original documents and other materials of various types. These include documents and correspondence of Bishop Alfred Lee and others relating to missionary work and related activities in Mexico between 1875 and 1915; a small collection of sermons, both manuscripts and typescripts, ranging from 1765 to 1931 and arranged alphabetically by author; books, articles, addresses, and similar writings by and about Protestant Episcopal bishops and church history; and a miscellany of documents, minutes, and so forth from Protestant Episcopal churches, as well as a scrapbook compiled by Chorley about the general convention of 1913. Series III contains drafts of books, articles, and addresses by Chorley, his notes on church history, and a diary for the year 1932 enclosing newspaper clippings and other items. It has only scattered entries.

Reverend Chorley donated these papers to Yale University in a series of gifts between 1937 and 1946. Materials related to these papers may be found in the Elisha Lord Cleaveland Papers (Manuscript Group Number 139) and the Protestant Episcopal Bishops Collection (Manuscript Group Number 21).
