Scope and Contents

This small collection is made up entirely of deeds and other legal documents, 1775-1846, pertaining to members of the Warner family living in and around Hamden, Connecticut. The deeds, sixteen of which are to Eldad Wolcott of Hamden, refer primarily to the land belonging to Ebenezer Warner (1733-1811), to his son Ebenezer (1767-1855), and to Amos Warner. Also among the papers are several writs, summonses, and subpoenas. The papers are arranged chronologically.

These documents were purchased for Yale University in 1948.
