Rights and Wrongs was a weekly television news magazine that ran from 1993 to 1996 and concerned global human rights issues. The program was hosted by Charlayne Hunter-Gault and was broadcast on 85 public television stations and in 35 foreign countries.

The records consist of videotapes, topical files, and other materials from the production, *Rights and Wrongs*, a weekly news magazine that ran from 1993 to 1996 and concerned global human rights issues.
