# **Processing Information**

This collection received a basic level of processing, including rehousing and in some instances minimal organization, at or around the time of receipt by the library. The finding aid for this collection was originally compiled from a preliminary list created at or around the time of receipt by the library. The preliminary list was migrated to comply with current archival descriptive standards in 2007-2008. As part of the migration, modifications were made to the formatting of the list; however, the content of the list was neither modified nor verified.

In October 2013, the following revisions were made to the organization of the material and to the finding aid: first, two series were identitified and created by moving non-correspondence into Series II. Other Papers; second, correspondents identifiable by their first name only were shifted from the alphabetized run of correspondents in Series I. to the end of the series; and third, updates were made to dates to conform to current conventions.

# Arthur Gold (1917-1990) and Robert Fizdale (1920-1995)

Arthur Gold and Robert Fizdale met while studying with Rosina Lhévinne and Ernest Hutcheson respectively at Juilliard. In 1944 the pianists formed a duo that survived until their retirement in 1982. They made their debut at the New School for Social Research in 1944 in a recital of music by John Cage and their reputations in the standard repertory were established with a Town Hall recital in 1946. Gold and Fizdale revived the Mendelssohn 2-piano concertos and expanded the repertory by commissioning works from Milhaud, Poulenc, Rieti, Berio, and other composers. Arthur Gold was born 6 Febuary 1917 in Toronto and died 3 January 1990 in New York City. Robert Fizdale was born 12 April 1920 in Chicago and died 6 December 1995 in New York City.
