Biographical / Historical

Ruth Barcan Marcus was a philosopher and a professor in the Yale University Philosophy Department, noted for her advances in the field of logic, as well as her outspoken advocacy for women in philosophy. Dr. Marcus was born Ruth Charlotte Barcan on August 2, 1921, and was raised in the Bronx, NY. She earned a bachelor's degree in mathematics and philosophy from New York University, as well as a master's degree and a doctorate in philosophy from Yale.

Dr. Marcus taught at Roosevelt University, the University of Illinois at Chicago, and at Northwestern University before joining the Yale faculty in 1973. She is noted for her advances in the quantification of modal logic and the theory of direct reference. She also wrote significant works on identity, essentialism, possibility, belief, and moral conflict. She is perhaps most well-known for the development of the Barcan formula, an essential thesis of modal logic. After retiring from Yale in 1992, Dr. Marcus taught at the University of California, Irvine. She died at her home in New Haven on February 19, 2012.

Collection Contents

Series I: Correspondence, 1937-2011

This series consists of a substantial body of both incoming and outgoing correspondence, primarily between Ruth Barcan Marcus and colleagues at Yale University, as well as in the broader philosophy field. The correspondence primarily concerns Marcus' scholarship, writings, and professional service, issues and goings-on within philosophy and academia, as well as solicitations of feedback from colleagues about their own work. In particular, her correspondence both up-and-coming and established female colleagues reflects her championing of the work of women philosophers, as well as the mentorship she provided to those of a younger generation.
