LANGUAGE: The material is in English.

SUMMARY: The collection consists of the diary of Elisha Spencer Benton, which he kept during his service with the U.S. Army Seventh Artillery in Puerto Rico during the Spanish American War. Entries concern his unit's movements, the supply situation, and measures to fight the spread of yellow fever among the soldiers. Benton also includes observations on the countryside, settlements, and people of Puerto Rico. Much of the journal concerns the period after the short American military campaign in Puerto Rico ended August 15, 1898. Entries are often days or weeks apart and some appear in the journal out of their chronological order. The journal also includes several letters regarding Benton's war service and other writings from before the war, including a play and a speech, which Benton copied onto the pages by hand.
