Administrative Information

Immediate Source of Acquisition

Processing Information

Collections are processed to a variety of levels, depending on the work necessary to make them usable, their perceived research value, the availability of staff, competing priorities, and whether or not further accruals are expected. The library attempts to provide a basic level of preservation and access for all

collections, and does more extensive processing of higher priority collections as time and resources permit.

The collection is comprised of material formerly classed as Uncat MS Vault 548.

Noël J. Cortés, collector

Noël J. Cortés was born in Manila in 1907, and became a naturalized citizen of the United States in 1932. He was a medical doctor and lived in Philadelphia where he was affiliated with the Drexel Institute of Technology. He was a collector of manuscripts, books, and artworks.

Scope and Contents

The collection consists of manuscript letters, writings, and documents, mostly in French, by writers, artists, historians, and philosophers, including Alexandre Dumas, Victor Hugo, Paul Morand, and George Sand.
