#### Scope and Contents

This finding aid encompasses accessions of single manuscripts and small groups of manuscripts and other papers, by or pertaining to the Boswell of Auchinleck family, which the library has chosen to group and list as an artificial collection. Materials incorporated into the collection prior to January 1995 have been organized into <u>Series I, Letters</u>, and <u>Series II, Writings</u>. Materials added to the collection since that time are located in Series II, Additions since July 1995, listed in the order in which they were added.
