Scope and Contents

This finding aid encompasses accessions of single manuscripts and small groups of manuscripts and other papers, by or pertaining to Dante Gabriel Rossetti, which the library has chosen to group and list as an artificial collection. Materials incorporated into the collection prior to June 1997 have been organized into three series. [Series I, Correspondence](#), principally contains items written by Rossetti, with one letter written to Rossetti by Charles Augustus Howell. The single item in [Series II, Writings](#), is a manuscript poem. The [Other Materials in Series III](#) consist of an autograph receipt and a set of playing cards painted by Rossetti at the age of 12.
