## JULES SUPERVIELLE (1884-1960)

Jules Supervielle, a poet, dramatist, and short-story writer of Basque descent, was born in Montevideo, Uruguay. He died in Paris in 1960.

## Scope and Contents

This finding aid encompasses accessions of single manuscripts and small groups of manuscripts and other papers, by or pertaining to Jules Supervielle, acquired by the library from a variety of sources. Materials incorporated into the collection prior to August 1999 have been organized into two series. [Series I, Writings](#), contains drafts of various plays and poems, and a printed version of *Débarcadères*, which has been annotated by Supervielle. [Series II, Letters](#), contains letters from Supervielle to Isabelle Clarke and Elie Richard, as well as drafts of letters to Felisberto Hernández and an unidentified correspondent.
